Bylaw No 509

a Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for general Township purposes; and for the several school sections as required by the Trustees of said sections.

Whereas power is given Municipal Councils to levy and collect rates, for all purposes above-mentioned.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows:

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the assessment roll for 1900, the sum of \$3591<sup>47</sup> Three thousand five hundred and ninety-one dollars and forty-two cents, being a rate of  $4\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$.

That is to say. For General Township purposes, the sum of \$945<sup>12</sup> nine hundred and forty-five dollars and twelve cents, being a rate of  $1\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$.

For General School purposes, the sum of \$1134<sup>15</sup> Eleven hundred and thirty-four dollars and fifteen cents being a rate of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$. For County purposes, the sum of \$1512<sup>20</sup>, fifteen hundred and twelve dollars and twenty cents, being a rate of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$.

And for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections as near as may be the following amounts.
