Bylaw No 525

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for general Township purposes, and for the General school and Trustee school rates, as required by Trustees.

Whereas power is given municipal councils to levy and collect rates for all purposes above mentioned:

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enact as follows:

That there be levied and collected from all the taxable property on the Assessment Roll for 1903. The sum of Three thousand five hundred and seven dollars and ninety seven cents, being a rate of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$.

That is to say. For General Township purposes. the sum of seven hundred and seventy nine dollars, and fifty five cents, being a rate of 1 mill on the \$. For General school purposes the sum of Eleven hundred and sixty-nine dollars and thirty two cents, being a rate of  $\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$. For County purposes the sum of fifteen hundred and fifty nine dollars and ten cents being a rate of 2 mills on the \$.

And for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said Sections as near as may be the following amounts:
