Bylaw No 537

a Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for General Township purposes, and for the General and Trustee school rates as required by Trustees.

Whereas the consolidated Municipal Act gives power to Municipal Councils, to levy and collect rates for all purposes above-mentioned.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury levacts as follows.

That there be levied and collected from all the ratable property on the Assessment Roll for 1905, the sum of \$3714⁷⁸, Three Thousand seven hundred and fourteen dollars and seventy-eight cents, being a rate of 4 mills on the \$. That is to say for General Township purposes, the sum of \$928⁷⁶ nine hundred and twenty-eight dollars and seventy cents, being a rate of 1 mill on the \$, for General school purposes, the sum of \$1160⁸⁶ Eleven hundred and sixty dollars and eighty-six cents, being a rate of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the \$, for County purposes, the sum of \$1625²² sixteen hundred and sixty-five dollars and twenty-two cents, being a rate of 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ mill on the \$, And for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections, as near as may be the following amounts: School Section No 1 - 150⁰⁰ & Deb 612⁵⁰.
