A Bylaw to appoint certain Township Officers for the Township of North Guillembury for the Year 1906.

Be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillembury

Bylaw no 543

A Bylaw to empower the Reue and Treasurer to borrow the sum of three hundred dollars, on the credit of the Township to meet current expenses until the Taxes are collected.

Be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Cullinbury; That the Reue and Treasurer be and are hereby empowered to borrow from the Metropolitan Bank Sutton the sum of three hundred dollars at the rate of six and a half per cent interest per annum

A Bylaw to assess for county purposes for General Township purposes and for the General and Trustee school rates as required by the Trustees.

Whereas the consolidated Municipal Act gives power to municipal councils, to levy and collect rates for all purposes above mentioned.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Wellington enacts as follows

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the assessment Roll for 1906 the sum of \$4987⁵⁰ four thousand nine hundred and eighty seven dollars and fifty cents being a rate of 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$, that is to say, for General Township purposes the sum of \$950⁰⁰ nine hundred and fifty Dollars, being a rate of 1 mill on the \$, for General school purposes, the sum of \$2375⁰⁰ two thousand three hundred and seventy-five Dollars being a rate of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the \$, for county purposes the sum of \$1662⁵⁰ sixteen hundred and sixty two dollars and fifty cents being a rate of 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ mills on the \$.

And for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections as near as may be the following amounts.
