Bylaw No 551

A Bylaw to assess for county purposes, for General Township purposes, and for the several school sections as the Law directs.

Whereas power is given Municipal Councils by the Consolidated Municipal Act, to levy and collect rates for all purposes above-mentioned,

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows,

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the assessment Roll for 1907, the sum of \$5368⁶⁸/₁₀₀ Five thousand three hundred and sixty-five dollars & sixty-eight cents being a rate of 5½ mills on the \$, that is to say for General Township purposes, the sum of \$1219⁴⁵/₁₀₀ Twelve hundred and nineteen dollars & forty-five cents being a rate of 1¼ mills on the \$, for General School purposes, the sum of \$2195⁰¹/₁₀₀ Two thousand one hundred and ninety-five dollars & one cent being a rate of 2¼ mills on the \$, for County purposes the sum of \$1957¹²/₁₀₀ Nineteen hundred and fifty-one dollars and twelve cents, being a rate of 2 mills on the \$,

And for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections as near as may be the following amounts

Of the Township of North Westlambton to accept the dedication of a certain road, It was it is desirable that the Municipal Council of the Township of North Westlambton shall accept the dedication by Robert Arthur Gilroy of the Road hereinafter described and shall consent to the same being so dedicated although such road is less than sixty-six feet in width.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of North Westlambton, ^{hereby} enacts as follows that the said council do hereby consent to the laying out and to the dedication by Robert Arthur Gilroy of the road as a public road described as follows;

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Township of North Westlambton in the County of York, and being part of Lot number eighteen in the second division of the said Township described as follows.

Being that piece of land commonly known as Gilroy's Lane, the western end thereof commencing on the eastern limit of the Lake Shore road immediately to the south of lot letter "A" on registered plan no 80, and thence running north eighty-three degrees east at the uniform breadth of thirty-three feet for a distance of five hundred and seventy-two feet six inches and thence inclining southerly until with a width of fifty feet it reaches the right of way of the Toronto & York Radial Railway Company, the centre line of the road so dedicated being, at the west end thereof, on the eastern limit of the Lake Shore road at the distance of six hundred and eighty-three feet from the north-west angle (measured in a southerly direction) of Lot letter (a) as shown on registered plan no 80.

And the easterly end of said centre line being on the westerly limit of the Right of way of the Toronto and York Radial Railway Company at the distance of seven hundred and seventy-seven six inches measured in a southerly direction along said right of way from the intersection of the northern boundary of Township lot no. 18, and the western limit of the aforesaid right of way,

2. That the said Municipal Council do hereby accept the said Road as a public Road of the said Township.
