Bylaw No 572

A Bylaw to assess for bounty purposes, for General Township purposes, and for the several school sections as the Law directs

Whereas power is given municipal councils by the Consolidated Municipal Act, to levy and collect rates for all purposes above-mentioned,

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Wellington enacts as follows

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the Assessment Roll for 1909 the sum of six thousand four hundred and forty-nine Dollars and sixty-two cents; being a rate of  $6\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$.

For General Township purposes, the sum seventeen hundred and thirty-six Dollars and forty-five cents, being a rate of  $1\frac{3}{4}$  mills on the \$.

For General school purposes, the sum of Twenty Two hundred and thirty-two Dollars and fifty-five cents, being a rate of  $2\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$.

For bounty purposes, the sum of Twenty-four hundred and eighty Dollars and sixty-two cents, being a rate of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$.

Bylaw No 572

A Bylaw to assess for bounty purposes, for General Township purposes, and for the several school sections as the Law directs.

Whereas power is given Municipal Councils by the Consolidated Municipalities to levy and collect rates for all purposes above-mentioned,

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Westlincbury enact as follows.

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the assessment Roll for 1909, the sum of (\$6449<sup>62</sup>/<sub>100</sub>) six thousand four hundred and forty nine Dollars and sixty two cents, being a rate of 6 1/2 mills on the \$.

That is to say; for General Township purposes, the sum of seventeen hundred and thirty six Dollars and forty five cents (\$1736<sup>45</sup>/<sub>100</sub>) being a rate of 1 3/4 mills on the \$.

For General school purposes. the sum of two thousand two hundred and thirty two Dollars and fifty five cents (\$2232<sup>55</sup>/<sub>100</sub>) being a rate of 2 1/4 mills on the \$.

For bounty purposes the sum of two thousand four hundred and eighty Dollars and sixty two cents, being a rate of 2 1/2 mills on the \$.
