a Bylaw to appoint certain Township Officers for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1910.

Be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury

W.H. 1st That John Hamilton Jr and John Marrett be and are hereby appointed Auditors to audit the accounts of the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1909, and that they receive the sum of \$3⁰⁰ each for their services as such.

W.H. 2nd That Milton Hamilton, be and is hereby appointed assessor for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1910, at a salary of \$70⁰⁰ seventy dollars.

W.H. 3rd That Ira Morton be and is hereby appointed collector for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1910, at a salary of \$55⁰⁰ fifty-five dollars.

W.H. 4th and that Jesse Comell be and is hereby appointed a member of the Board of Health for a period of three years

Bylaw no 576

A Bylaw to restrain and regulate the running at large of dogs in the Township of North Gwillimbury.

As provided by section 540 of the consolidated Municipal Act; the council of the corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enact as follows.

1st that all dogs within said Township must either be securely chained in an outhouse or other building, or kept under lock and key, or kept constantly muzzled with effective metallic muzzles, until the Government regulations regarding rabies are withdrawn.

2nd Any dog found at large and unmuzzled may be killed; and the owner or harbourer of said dog shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$5⁰⁰ and not exceeding \$200⁰⁰.

3rd This Bylaw shall take effect and be in full force March 14th 1910.

A Bylaw to authorize - the Sutton and North Gwillimbury Co-operative Telephone Company limited, to erect and maintain poles and wires on certain public highways of the municipality of the Township of North Gwillimbury; and for the carrying on of a Telephone business in the said municipality.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enact as follows
(1st) that the Sutton and North Gwillimbury, Co-operative Telephone Company, have the right to use the following highways of this municipality, for the purpose of erecting poles and wires thereon and for maintaining the same, and for the conduct of a Telephone business; that is to say the stage road from Sutton to Lowelline between East and North Gwillimbury, the Valley-road from Rievier north to Lot Locality Two; and such other roads as may be authorized by resolution of the Council of the Township of North Gwillimbury.
(2nd) The location of the poles upon the highway and the quality, size and length of the poles, and the work shall be under the approval of the road and bridge committee and said work shall not interfere with the traffic on said highways, or with the business of any private citizen.

(3rd) the said company shall not have the exclusive right for said franchise, and shall make good any damage that may occur to any person travelling on the highway during the construction and operation of the said Telephone line.

Bylaw No 579

A Bylaw to authorize the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury to borrow certain sums to meet current expenditure.

Whereas the Taxes levied for the current year expenditure of the said Corporation for the year have not yet been fully collected, there being uncollected of such Taxes a sum not less than the sum hereby authorized to be borrowed.

And whereas the sum of Five hundred Dollars will be required to meet the current expenses of the said Corporation during the current year before the taxes levied therefor are collected, and it is expedient subject to the conditions hereinafter contained to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow the said sum;

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury as follows:-

1st That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation, be and they are hereby authorized, under the seal of the Corporation, but only in the manner and subject to the conditions below mentioned, to borrow from the Metropolitan Bank the sum of Five hundred Dollars required to meet the now current expenditure of said Corporation; provided always that the amount so borrowed and outstanding shall not at any time exceed the amount which may be legally borrowed, under the Consolidated Municipal Act, to meet the now current expenditure of said Corporation.

- 2nd That the Head with the Treasurer aforesaid be, and they are hereby authorized to pay or allow the said Bank interest on the said sum so borrowed at the rate of six per cent per annum.
- 3rd That promissory note repayable on or before the last business day of the current year, sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Reeve and Treasurer be duly executed and given to the said Bank as aforesaid, as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed with interest thereon as aforesaid.

Bylaw No 580^{ao}

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes for General Township purposes and for the several School sections as the Law directs.

Whereas power is given Municipal Councils by the Consolidated Municipal Act to levy and collect rates for all purposes above-mentioned,

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury directs as follows

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the assessment Roll for 1910, the sum of \$6078⁰⁰ six thousand and seconty-eight dollars, being a rate of 6 mills on the \$.

That is to say for General Township purposes, the sum of \$1519⁵⁰ fifteen hundred and nineteen dollars and fifty cents, being a rate of 1½ mills on the \$.

For General School purposes, the sum of (2279²⁵) Two thousand two hundred and seventy-nine dollars and twenty-five cents, being a rate of 2¼ mills on the \$;

For County purposes the sum of (2279²⁵) Two thousand two hundred and seventy-nine dollars and twenty-five cents, being a rate of 2¼ mills on the \$; and for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections as near as may be the following amounts:

A Bylaw to empower the Trustees of School section No 3 of the Township of North Gwillimbury, to raise by way of loan, the sum of three thousand Dollars, for payment of new school House.

Whereas the Trustees of school section No 3, have made application to the council as required by Sec 90 of the Public Schools Act, to raise by Debentures the sum of \$3000⁰⁰ Three Thousand Dollars; the proposal for such loan having been approved and sanctioned at a special meeting of the ratepayers of said section called for the purpose.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enact as follows:

That the Trustees of the above-mentioned section are hereby empowered to borrow on the credit of said section, the sum of Three Thousand Dollars \$3000⁰⁰, to be paid in ten annual instalments of \$300⁰⁰ each, together with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent per annum from the fifteenth day of December 1910, on which date the first Debenture shall be made payable, said amounts and interest thereon the same to be levied and collected on the property in said section in the years 1910. 1911. 1912. 1913. 1914. 1915. 1916. 1917. 1918. 1919; in addition to all other taxes that may be required; and that Debentures be issued for the same.
