

A Bylaw to appoint certain Township Officers for the Township of North Guillemburg for the Year 1911.

Be it enacted by the council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg.

1<sup>st</sup> That John Marritt and John Hamilton be and are hereby appointed auditors to audit the accounts of the Township of North Guillemburg for the Year 1910, and that they receive the sum of three dollars each, for their services as such.

2<sup>nd</sup> That Milton Hamilton be and is hereby appointed assessor for the Township of North Guillemburg for the Year 1911, at a salary of ~~fifty-five~~ <sup>seventy</sup> Dollars,

3<sup>rd</sup> That Ira Norton be and is hereby appointed collector for the Township of North Guillemburg for the Year 1911, at a salary of fifty-five dollars.

4<sup>th</sup> And that Charles A. Stephens be and is hereby appointed a member of the Board of Health for a period of three years.

Bylaw no 586

A Bylaw to prohibit the sale <sup>by retail</sup> of spirituous, fermented or other manufactured liquors in the municipality of the Township of North Guillemburg.

The municipal Council of the Township of North Guillemburg hereby enacts as follows;

1<sup>st</sup>, That the sale by retail of spirituous, fermented or other manufactured liquors is and shall be prohibited in every tavern, inn or other house or place of public entertainment in the said Municipality and the sale thereof, except by wholesale, is and shall be prohibited in every shop or place other than a house of public entertainment in the said Municipality.

2<sup>nd</sup>, That the vote of the electors of the said Township of North Guillemburg, be taken on this Bylaw by the Deputy-Returning Officers hereinafter named on Monday the second day of January, One thousand nine hundred and Eleven, commencing at nine o'clock in the morning, and continuing until five o'clock in the afternoon at the undermentioned place

3<sup>rd</sup> That on the sixteenth day of December, A. D. 1910, at his office in the Township of North Guillemburg, at the hour of Two o'clock in the forenoon, the Reeve shall appoint in writing, signed by himself, two persons to attend at the final summing up of the votes by the clerk, and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the passing of this Bylaw and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of opposing the passing of this Bylaw.

4<sup>th</sup> That the Clerk of the said Municipal Council of the Township of North Guillemburg shall attend at his office, at the hour of eleven o'clock in the forenoon on the fourth day of January A. D. 1911, to sum up the ~~total~~ number of votes given for and against this Bylaw,

5<sup>th</sup> This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect as from the first day of May next after the final passing thereof

To confirm an agreement for the closing of a public ~~highway~~ road and opening of a public road in lieu thereof.

Whereas by an agreement dated 27<sup>th</sup> February 1911, made between David Hamilton et al and the Municipal Corporation of the Township of North Westlincumbury.

The said Corporation has agreed to close and convey that portion of the old road established by Quarter Sessions in November 1835, which crosses Lot 24 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and third concession of the said Township to the said persons; and in lieu thereof they have agreed to sell, grant and convey a strip of land to be used as a public road along the southerly limit of the said Lot as more fully described in said agreement; and also to grant the use of a certain other road, the said Township also agreeing, as more fully set forth in said agreement.

Therefore the Municipal Corporation of the Township of North Westlincumbury in Council assembled enact as follows.

2<sup>nd</sup> That the Reeve and Clerk of the said Township are hereby authorized and empowered to execute the said agreement and attach the corporate seal thereto.

1<sup>st</sup> The said agreement is hereby ratified and confirmed.

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for General Township purposes; and for the several school sections as the Law directs.

Whereas power is given Municipal Councils by the consolidated Municipal Act, to levy and collect Rates, for all purposes above-mentioned.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemetry enact as follows.

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property, on the Assessment Roll for 1911, the sum of \$6506<sup>25</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Six thousand five hundred and six Dollars and Twenty-five Cents, being a rate of 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Mills on the \$,

That is to say. For General Township purposes the sum of \$1561<sup>50</sup>/<sub>100</sub> One thousand five hundred and sixty one dollars and fifty cents, being a rate of 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Mills on the \$.

For General school purposes. The sum of \$2342<sup>25</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Two thousand three hundred and forty two dollars and Twenty-five cents, being a rate of 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Mills on the \$.

For County purposes, the sum of \$2602<sup>50</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Two thousand six hundred and two dollars and fifty cents, being a rate of 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Mills on the \$.

And for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections as near as may be the following amounts,

## Bylaw No 590

Municipal Corporation of the  
 Of the Township of North Willimburg;

Whereas one David Hamilton of the Township of North Willimburg has been in possession of a Road-allowance, along upon and across a portion of farm lot number Seventy-four in the second and third concessions of said Township, as laid out by order of the Quarter Sessions or General Sessions of the Peace for the Home district, known as the Arch Smalley or Lake shore road, extending from the easterly limit of what is known as the Miller, or Warden property; and extending therefrom in an easterly direction in the manner shown by aforesaid order, to the westerly limit of what is known as the Verin Road;

And whereas the said David Hamilton has opened up or caused to have opened up a parallel Road across said lot Seventy-four in the second concession of said Township extending from what is known as the Roach's Point Road, easterly along the southerly boundary of said lot Seventy-four to the northerly boundary of the lands of the Toronto and York Radial Railway, thence along the northerly boundary of said last mentioned lands to what is known as the Ridout Road, as shown on registered Plan No 110, for the said Township (as will more readily appear by reference to a conveyance made by the said David Hamilton and others to this



corporation bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1911, in place of the aforesaid firstly mentioned Road, without receiving<sup>ing</sup> compensation therefor, which the Council of this Corporation deems sufficient for the purpose of a Highway in lieu of the "Smally Road".

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Quillimbury, that this Corporation do grant and convey the lands and premises comprised within the boundaries of the said Smally or Lake-Shore Road from the easterly limit of the Warder or Miller property hereinbefore mentioned to the westerly limit of the Verrier Road hereinbefore mentioned, by such a good and sufficient deed of bargain and sale as this Council has power to grant, and when such conveyance is prepared that the Reeve and Clerk do execute the same in the manner, laid down by the Municipal Act<sup>s</sup> respecting sales of real estate by Municipal Corporations.

## Bylaw no 591

Of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of North Wellington.

Whereas by Bylaw number 590 of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of North Wellington, the Council did order and direct that a certain Roadway, the limits of which will more readily appear by reference to such Bylaw, should be conveyed to one David Hamilton, in lieu of a Roadway laid out by ~~the~~ said Hamilton and others.

And whereas the Council has accepted of the roadway so laid out by said Hamilton and others, as a Public Highway, by deed bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 1911,

Now therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Wellington, that the lands and premises mentioned in the said conveyance from the said Hamilton and others being a strip of land thirty<sup>three</sup> feet in width extending along the southern boundary of farm lot number Twenty Four, in the second Concession of the Township of North Wellington aforesaid from the easterly limits of the Roads Point Road, to the northerly limits of the Toronto and York Radial Railway lands; thence a strip of land forty feet in width along the northerly limits of said Radial Railway lands extending from the intersection of said thirty<sup>three</sup> foot said Road easterly to the westerly limit of what is known as the Ridout Road, be and the same be accepted as a Public Highway by the said Corporation.
