By-Law No. 614

A By-Law to authorize the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg to borrow certain sums of money to meet the now current expenditure.

Whereas the Taxes levied for the current expenditure of the said Corporation for the year have not yet been fully collected the being uncollected of such Taxes a sum not less than the sum ^{hereby} authorized to ^{be} borrowed.

And whereas the sum of Two Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars will be required to meet the current expenses of said Corporation during the current year before the Taxes levied thereon are collected and it is expedient subject to the conditions hereinafter contained, to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow said sum.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg as follows.

1st. That the Head with the Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized under the seal of the Corporation, but only in the manner and subject to the conditions below mentioned, to borrow from the Metropolitan Bank the sum of Two Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars to meet the now current expenditure of said Corporation: provided always that the amount so borrowed and outstanding shall not at any time exceed the amount which may be legally borrowed, under the consolidated municipal Act, to meet the now current expenditure of said Corporation

2nd That the Head with the Treasurer aforesaid, be and they are hereby authorized to pay or allow the said Bank interest on said sum so borrowed at the rate of six per cent, per Annum.

3rd That a promissory note repayable on or before the last business day of the current year sealed with the Corporate seal and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Head and Treasurer be duly executed and given to the said Bank as aforesaid as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed with interest thereon as aforesaid,

A By-Law for commuting Statute Labor under the R. S. C. 1914, Sec. V. See 1, Chap. 47.

By. Law. No. 616.

A. By. Law to assess for County purposes for Township purposes and the several school sections as the law directs

Whereas power is given Municipal Councils by the consolidated Municipal Act to levy and collect rates for all purposes above mentioned,

That the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows

1 That there be levied and collected on all the rateable property on the assessment Roll for the year 1914, the sum of Seven thousand Five hundred forty four Dollars and seventy Eight cents being at the rate of 6 3/10 mills on the dollar.

2 That is to say for general township purposes the sum of Two thousand Eight hundred and thirty Dollars being at the rate of 2 3/10 Mills on the Dollar,

3 For general school purposes the sum of Two thousand one hundred and seventy Five dollars being at the rate of 1 8/10 Mills on the \$,

4 For county purposes the sum of Two thousand Five hundred and thirty nine dollars and Seventy Eight cents being at the rate of 2 2/10 Mills on the Dollar.

5 For to pay Debenture No. 1. Thompson bridge the sum of Five hundred and Eighty Two Dollars and Seventy Five cents, being at the rate of 1/2 Mill on the Dollar.

6 For the several school sections as near as maybe the following amounts,
