By Law. 672.

A. By Law to assess for Township purposes county purposes and the several school sections as the Law directs,

Whereas power is given municipal councils by the consolidated municipal act, to levy and collect Rates for all purposes above mentioned,

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilford as follows.

That there be levied and collected on all the Rate-able property on the assessment Roll for the year 1920 the sum of sixteen thousand Ten dollars and ninety cents, being at the Rate of  $12\frac{3}{10}$  Mills on the Dollar,

That is to say for general Township purposes the sum of three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars being at the rate of  $2\frac{3}{10}$  Mills on the Dollar,

For general school purposes the sum of four thousand, three hundred and fifty dollars being at the rate of  $3\frac{3}{10}$  Mills on the \$

For County purposes the sum of eight thousand four hundred and Ten dollars and ninety eight cents being at the rate of  $6\frac{3}{10}$  Mills on the Dollar,

The special Tax for Oiling the Road from Keswick to the 4<sup>th</sup> Con. By the Lake Shore Road, the sum of seven hundred dollars being at the Rate of  $2\frac{3}{10}$  Mills on the Dollar,

For special Tax for street lighting payable by the residents of the Village of Keswick, under a signed petition, the sum of \$200.<sup>00</sup> being in a portion of \$400 each.

For the several school sections as near as may be the following amounts,

S. S. No. 1. \$600.<sup>00</sup>, No. 2. \$900.<sup>00</sup>, No. 3. \$700.<sup>00</sup>

By Law No. 674

A By-Law to Authorize the Borrowing of Money to meet <sup>current</sup> ordinary expenditure account for the year 1920.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury

Whereas it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury to borrow the sum of One Thousand dollars to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation for the year until the Taxes are paid,

And whereas the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding for the purposes aforesaid, and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Sec. 319 of Chapter 192 of the revised statutes of Ontario,

Be it therefore enacted as follows,

That the Head and the Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from the Bank of Nova Scotia on the note of the Corporation or by way of overdraft, or otherwise, the sum of One Thousand dollars, (\$1000.00) until such time as the Taxes levied or to be levied, shall be collected and applied to repay such advance,

That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and the Treasurer and the Bank,

That the Head and the Treasurer may draw make and deliver promissory notes bills or other securities and documents as may be agreed on to secure the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-Law,

That the Head and the Treasurer may enter into an agreement with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the said sum by the said Corporation by and the repayment of the same on or before the last business day for the current year, together with all other with all other terms relating to such borrowing and repayment as the said Head and Treasurer may deem necessary,
