A. By. Law to appoint certain Township Officers for the year 1923.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilimbury as follows,

That N. W. Wade and Allan Smallwood be and are hereby appointed Auditors to audit the Township accounts for the year 1922. and that they receive the sum of Ten Dollars each for their services as such

That Howard W. Wroughton be and is hereby appointed assessor for the year 1923 and that he receive the sum of One Hundred and Sixty Dollars as such in addition to the fees provided by statute,

That Jesse Connell be and is hereby appointed a member of the local Board of Health for a period of one year.

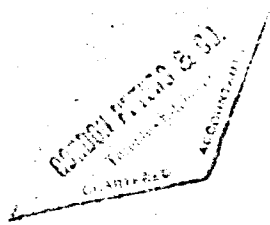
That Joseph Sheppard be and is hereby appointed Truant Officer for the year 1923 and that he receive the sum of Forty Dollars for his services as such.

And that all By. Laws or parts of By. Laws inconsistent with this By. Law be and are hereby repealed.

By-Law, No. 706,

Whereas it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilford to borrow the sum of Eight Thousand dollars to meet the current expenditure of the corporation and the sums required to be raised in the current year for high and public school purposes until the Taxes are collected,

And whereas the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under section 319 of Chapter 192 of the revised statutes of Ontario,

Be it therefore enacted as a By-Law by the said Council as follows,

That the Head and the Treasurer of the said Corporation be and They are hereby authorized to borrow from the Bank of Nova Scotia on the note of the Corporation or by way of overdraft, or otherwise the sum of \$8000.00 until such time as the Taxes levied on to be levied, shall be collected and applied to repay such advance,

That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head the Treasurer and the Bank,

That the Head and the Treasurer may draw make and deliver promissory notes, bills or other securities and documents as may be agreed on, to secure the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-Law,

That the Head and the Treasurer may enter into an agreement with the said Bank, sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and Treasurer, providing for the borrowing of the said sum by the said Corporation, and the repayment of the same on or before the last business day of the current year, together with all other terms relating to such borrowing, and repayment as the said Head and Treasurer may deem necessary

By Law No. 407

Whereas the taxes levied on to be levied of the current expenditure of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilford for the year 1923, have not been collected and there is or will be payable in respect of such taxes a sum sufficient to authorize the borrowing hereinafter provided for,

And whereas the Council of the said Corporation deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$5000.00 to meet the now current expenditure of the said Corporation, and it is expedient to authorize the borrowing of the said sum upon the credit of the Corporation,

And whereas it appears by the estimates for the current year that there will be required to pay the ordinary current expenditure of the Municipality the sum of \$5000.00

And whereas the ordinary expenditure of the Corporation for the year immediately preceding was \$,

And whereas the amount now borrowed and all other borrowings made by the Corporation this year do not amount to more than per cent of the ordinary current expenditure of the Corporation for the year immediately preceding as shown in by the amount in the preceding paragraph,

And whereas no sum has been borrowed on is now outstanding in respect of any borrowing to meet the now current expenditure of the Corporation for the present year except;

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilford as follows,

The Head or acting Head for the time being with the Treasurer of the said Corporation is hereby authorized to borrow in one or more sums, as the same may be required, from the Sterling Bank of Canada hereinafter called the Bank, an amount not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of \$5000.00 being the amount which the said Council deems necessary to meet the now current expenditure of the said Corporation until such time as the taxes levied on to be levied thereon can be collected,

The head or acting head of the said Corporation with the Treasurer aforesaid shall have authority to pay or allow the said Bank interest on the said sums as borrowed at such rate or rates as may be from time to time agreed upon, with interest payable in advance and may be deducted from the amounts so borrowed,

Any promissory note or notes, covenants or agreements which may be required by the said Bank may be sealed with corporate seal and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Reeve and Treasurer thereof, and duly executed and delivered to the said Bank, which said note or notes covenants or agreements shall obligate the Corporation to repay the said sums to be borrowed, together with interest thereon as aforesaid at such times as may be agreed upon,

If the amounts to be paid by virtue of any such note or notes covenants or agreements, may be executed shall not have been fully paid at maturity any further note or notes covenants or agreements may be executed as aforesaid on behalf of the Corporation and delivered to the Bank by way of renewal of the said obligations in whole or in part,

The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply so much of the Taxes so to be collected as may be necessary in payment of the obligations of the Corporation created as aforesaid,

By-Law No. 409

A. By-Law appointing a road overseer for the Township of North Gwillimbury in the County of York,

Whereas it is desirable that the laying out and supervision of all work and expenditure upon improvement and maintenance of Roads within the exclusive district of this Township, should be under the supervision of a road overseer, acting under the direction of the Council

and whereas it is the desire of this Council to take advantage of the Ontario highways Act, 1915, and to receive the government grant as provided in section 11, subsection 1 of the said Act;

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of North Gwillimbury as follows,

That Wm. L. Wink is appointed road overseer in the said Township to act as aforesaid in accordance with the provisions of the said section 11 of the said Act, from the 1st day Jan 1923 and during the pleasure of the said Council,

That the said Wm. L. Wink shall be paid at the rate of \$3.⁵⁰ per day for such time as he may be employed,

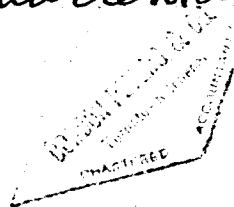
That it shall be the duty of the overseer to lay out and supervise all work and expenditure on roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Township Council, and to conform to such general regulations as the Department of Public Highways may prescribe,

That all By-Laws or parts thereof and all or any resolutions of said Council contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed,

That a certified copy of this By-Law be forwarded by the Clerk without delay to the Deputy Minister, Department of Public Highways, Toronto,

By-Law No. 710

A. By-Law to provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of North Guillemburg during the year 1923,

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on Township Roads under the Ontario Highways Act, and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually, by Township By-Law,

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg enacts as follows,

The sum of \$5000.⁰⁰ is hereby appropriated from monies raised by Taxes for expenditure upon construction on the roads in the said Township during the year 1923,

The sum of \$6000.⁰⁰ is hereby appropriated from monies raised by Taxes for expenditure upon maintenance and repair on the roads in the said Township during the year 1923,

The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed road-superintendent,

All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting Township Roads, issued by the Department of Public Highways of Ontario,

The Clerk shall transmit two copies of this By-Law to the Deputy Minister, of Public Highways of Ontario, within thirty days after the passing thereof.

A. By. Law to Amend By. Law No. 705

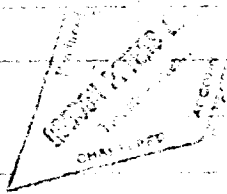
Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilford, as follows,

By Law No. 412,

A. By Law to assess for Township purposes, County purposes and the several school sections as the law directs,

whereas power is given municipal councils by the consolidated municipal act, to levy and collect rates for all purposes above mentioned,

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Willimbury as follows,

That there be levied and collected on all rateable property on the assessment Roll for the year 1923 the sum of Twenty Thousand seven Hundred and nine dollars and twelve cents, being at the rate of 12 7/10 mills on the dollar,

That is to say for general Township purposes the sum of Four Thousand and Forty Four dollars and seventy five cents being at the rate of 25 7/10 mills on the dollar,

For general school purposes the sum of Four thousand eight hundred and fifty three dollars and seventy cents being at the rate of 3 mills on the dollar,

For county purposes the sum of Ten thousand one hundred and ninety two dollars and seventy seven cents being at the rate of 6 3/10 mills on the dollar,

For paying the Debentures on the Brecken bridge the sum of one thousand six hundred and seventeen dollars and ninety cents being at the rate of one mill on the dollar,

The special Tax for ciling the Road from Keswick to Jacksons point the sum of sixteen Hundred dollars being at the rate of 3 mills on the dollar,

The Special Tax for street lighting payable by the residents of Keswick, the sum of Three Hundred and Forty Two dollars, being in the portion of \$6.50 each.

For the several school sections as near as may be the following amounts, S.S. No. 1. \$700.00 No. 2. \$1500.00 No. 3. \$750.00 No. 4. \$700.00 No. 5. \$700.00 No. 6. \$1200.00 No. 7. \$250.00 Union \$78.00

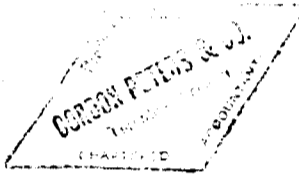

If the amounts to be paid by virtue of any such note or notes, covenants or agreements, shall not have been fully paid at maturity, any further note or notes, covenants or agreements may be executed as aforesaid on behalf of the Corporation and delivered to the Banks by way of renewal of the said obligation in whole or in part.

The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply so much of the said Taxes so to be collected as may be necessary in payment of the obligations of the Corporation created as aforesaid.
