4. That a copy of This bylaw be forwarded to the Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within one month of the passing thereof.

## Bylaw 774.

A Bylaw to Provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of North Gwillimbury during the year 1927.

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on Township roads under the Highways Improvement Act and Amendments thereto shall be provided for annually by Township Bylaw.

Therefore the council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows.

1. The sum of \$20,000 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by Levy for expenditure upon construction and maintenance on the roads in the said Township during the year 1927, as follows.

4. The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this Bylaw to the Deputy Minister, Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within 30 days after the passing thereof.

A By Law appointing a Road Superintendent for the Township of North Gwillimbury in the County of York.

Whereas it is desirable that the laying out & supervision of all work and expenditure upon improvement and maintenance of roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of this township, shall be under the supervision of a road Superintendent, acting under the direction of this Council.

And whereas it is the desire of this Council to take advantage of the Highway Improvement Act, and to receive the Government Grant as provided in Sec. 43 & 45 of the said Act.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the said Township of North Gwillimbury & it is hereby enacted:

1. That Carson Pollock is appointed road Superintendent in said Township to act as aforesaid in accordance with the provisions of the said Sec. 45 of the said Act from the 1st day of March 1927 and during the pleasure of the said Council.
  2. That the said Superintendent shall be paid at the rate of \$4.00 per day for such time as he may be so employed.
  3. That it shall be the duty of the Superintendent to lay out and supervise all work and expenditure on roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Township Council & to conform to such general regulations as the Department of Public Highways may prescribe.
  4. That all bylaws or parts thereof and all or any resolutions of said Council contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
  5. That a certified copy of this By Law, be forwarded by clerk, without delay, to the Deputy Minister, Dept. of Public Highways, Toronto.

A Bylaw to Authorize the Head & Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg to borrow certain sums to meet the now current expenditure.

Whereas the taxes levied for the current expenditure of the said Corporation for the year have not been fully collected, there being uncollected of such taxes a sum not less than the sum hereby authorized to be borrowed.

And whereas the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) is required to meet the now current expense of the said Corporation, and it is expedient to authorize the Head & Treasurer to borrow the said sum.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg as follows.

1. That the Head with the Treasurer of the said Corporation be, and they are hereby authorized, under the seal of the Corporation to borrow from the Standard Bank of Canada the sum of \$2,000.00 Two Thousand Dollars required to meet the now current expenditure of the said Corporation.
2. That the said Head with the Treasurer aforesaid, be, and they are hereby authorized to pay or allow the said Bank interest on the said sum so borrowed at the rate of 6 per cent per annum.
3. That a promissory note or notes covenant or agreement, sealed with the corporate seal, and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Reeve and Treasurer, be duly executed and given to the said Bank as aforesaid as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed, with interest thereon as aforesaid.
4. That the Standard Bank of Canada be and is hereby appointed Banker of the Corporation and is hereby authorized to pay and honor all cheques and orders for the payment of money made, signed or drawn in the name of the said Corporation by Reeve & Treasurer and further to accept for deposits to the credit of the Corporation all cheques, drafts, notes, bills and other negotiable instruments endorsed in the name of the said Corporation by the Reeve and Treasurer.

A Bylaw to Authorize the Head & Treasurer of the Corporation of North Yowellimbury to Borrow money to meet current ordinary expenditure for the year 1927.

Where as it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Yowellimbury to borrow the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10000) to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation for the year until the Taxes are paid.

And whereas the amount hereto fore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section 319. The Consolidated Municipal Act 1922 being 12-13 George V. Chapter 72 (Ord. and Amending Act).

Be it Therefore Enacted as a Bylaw by the said Council as follows.

1. That the Head & the Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to Borrow from the Bank of Nova Scotia on the note of the Corporation, or by way of Overdraft, or otherwise the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars until such time as the Taxes levied or to be levied, shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.
2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head & the Treasurer and the Bank.
3. That the Head and the Treasurer may draw, make and deliver promissory notes, bills or other securities and documents as may be agreed on, to secure the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this Bylaw.
4. That the head and the Treasurer may enter into an agreement with the said Bank, sealed with the corporate seal & signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the head & Treasurer, providing for the borrowing of the said sum by the said Corporation and the repayment of the same on or before the last business day of the current year, together with all other terms relating to such borrowing and repayment as the said Head & Treasurer may deem necessary. Passed by the Council this 25 day of April in the year four thousand 1927.

## By Law 778

A Bylaw of the Township of North Gwillimbury to Create a new Polling Subdivision in the said Township and to alter the boundaries of the three present polling subdivisions in the said Township.

Whereas by Bylaw No 252. passed on the 22nd day of July 1872. The Township of North Gwillimbury was divided into three subdivisions.

And whereas it is provided by twelve & thirteen Geo. V. Chap 72. Sec. 391. That the council of any Municipality may by Bylaw alter existing polling subdivisions or create a new polling Sub-division.

And whereas it is deemed expedient that the number of Polling Subdivisions in the Township of North Gwillimbury be increased to four.

Now Therefore be it enacted that the said Bylaw No 252. and all Bylaws, if any, amending same be and they are hereby repealed and that the said Township, be and it is hereby divided into four polling Sub Division as follows.

Subdivision No 1 to be composed of the following territory:

Commencing at a point which is formed by the intersection of the southerly limit of the said Township and the Easterly shore of Lake Simcoe. — Thence easterly along the said southerly limit of said Township to the fourth Concession line. — Thence northerly along the said fourth Concession line to the northerly limit of Lot 20 in the third Concession of the said Township. — Thence westerly along the northerly limit of the said Lot 20 and its projection westerly to the said Easterly shore of the said Lake Simcoe. — Thence southerly & southeasterly along the said Eastern Shore of Lake Simcoe to the point of beginning.

Subdivision No 2.

To be composed of the following Territory. — Commencing at the intersection of the 4th Concession line of the said Township and the Radial Railway line, now owned and operated by the Toronto Transportation



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commission and herein before operated by the Hydro Electric Power Commission;

Thence southerly along the said 4th Concession line to the southerly limit of the said Township;

Thence easterly along the said southerly limit of the said Township to the 6th concession line of the said Township; — Thence northerly along the said 6th concession line of said Township to the said Electric Railway line;

Thence westerly along the said Electric Railway line to the point of beginning.

### Subdivision No 3.

To be composed of the following Territory. Commencing at the intersection of the said Electric Railway line and the 6th Concession of the said Township.

Thence southerly along the said 6th Concession to the southerly limit of the said Township;

Thence easterly along the said southerly limit of the said Township to the 8th concession of the said Township;

Thence northerly along the said eighth concession of the said Township to the said Electric Railway line; — Thence westerly along the said Electric Railway line to the place of beginning.

### Subdivision No 4.

To be composed of the following Territory. — Commencing at the intersection of the said Electric Railway line and the eighth concession of the said Township; — Thence

northerly to the southerly shore of Lake Simcoe; Thence westerly and southerly and southerly by east along the southerly shore of Lake Simcoe and along the said easterly shore and along the said north easterly shore of the said Lake Simcoe to a point which is formed by the intersection of the projection westerly of the northerly limit of lot 20 Concession 3rd of the said Township and the said easterly shore of the said Lake Simcoe, which said point is the north westerly corner of the herein before polling Subdivision No 1. —

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Thence easterly along the said projection of the said northerly limit of lot 20 in the said Concession No 3 and along the northerly limit of the said lot 20 in the said concession No 3 to the fourth concession of the said Township.

Thence northerly along the said fourth concession of the said Township to the intersection of the said Electric Railway Line and the said fourth concession. Thence easterly along the said Electric Railway line to the place of beginning.

A By law to provide for the establishment of a Community Hall in the Township of North Gwillimbury

Whereas under the Statutes of Ontario 1920 Chap 72 & amendments thereto. The Council of Township may by By Law provide for the establishment of a Community Hall & issue debentures for the payment thereof. And

Whereas the Municipal Council of the Township of N. Gwillimbury has been petitioned by more than one half of the Members of rate payers of said Township of N. Gwillimbury asking for the erection of such Community Hall.

Be it therefore enacted and the Municipal Council of the Municipality of the Township of N. Gwillimbury enact as follows.

1. That the Council of the Township of N. Gwill. be & they are hereby authorized to purchase the premises situated in the village of Belhaven in Township of N. Gwillimbury comprising one 1/2 acre more or less. from one James Stevenson at a price of (\$375) Three Hundred & Seventy five Dollars. for the purpose of erecting thereon a Community Hall as aforesaid.

And That the said Municipal Council be & they are hereby authorized to erect upon the said premises in the village of Belhaven in Township of N. Gwillimbury a community Hall at a cost of seven thousand and five hundred Dollars.

3rd That said community Hall shall be under the management & control of a board appointed by the Council as provided for by the Statutes of Ontario 1920 Chap 72. & amendments thereto

A By Law to provide for & to borrow by the issue & sale of Debentures. Monies for the purpose of the purchase of a School Site & the erection of a school in School section No 2. of the Township of North Gwillimbury in the County of York.

Whereas the Public School Board of School Sec. No 2 of Township of N. Gwillimbury have requisitioned the Municipal Council of the Municipality of the Township of N. Gwillimbury in the County of York for the purchase of a school site and the erection thereon of a public school in the said school section No 2. in the Township of N. Gwillimbury.

And whereas the total amount required for the said purpose of the purchase of a school site and the erection of a public school thereon is the sum of \$20,000.

And whereas the amount of the whole rateable property of the said Municipality of Township of N. Gwillimbury according to the last revised assessment roll amounts to \$174,6200.

And whereas the amount of the existing Debenture debit of the said Municipality of Township of N. Gwillimbury is \$3,864.90. Being Debenture on Breckow Bridge.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of the Township of N. Gwillimbury enacts as follows.

That it shall be lawful for the Reeve of the said municipality and he is thereby authorized for the purpose aforesaid to borrow the sum of \$20,000. & to issue Debentures under the seal of the Corporation to the amount of \$20,000. in sums of not less than \$100 each. payable in a period within 30 years with interest at Rate of 5% Per annum in equal installments with interest as set forth in this schedule hereto annexed.

That the said Debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation & signed by the Reeve & Treasurer & known as & marked. School Section No 2 debentures.

That the said Debentures shall be payable at the Standard Bank of Canada. & interest on the days & times set forth in the following schedule.

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That for the repayment of the said Debentures from year to year as they mature there shall be levied in each and every year during the said period of 30 years on all the rateable property of the said Municipality within the limits of S. S. No 2 of the said Township of N. Guillemburg in addition to all other rates. The sum of \$1301.03 being a sum sufficient to pay the several installments of principal & interest accruing due on the said debt as provided in the following schedule.

A Bylaw to provide for the borrowing of money by the issue and sale of debentures for the purpose of constructing a bridge upon the highway in the 7th Concession in the Township of N. Gwillimbury on the side road between lots 15 & 16 in the 1st said concession & known as The Chapelle Bridge.
