A By Law to appoint Certain Township Officers for the Year 1928.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of North Guilfimbury & Corporation Thereof as follows.

1. That the Assessor be H. H. Willoughby and he is hereby appointed Assessor for the year 1928 and that he shall receive the sum of (\$275.00) Two Hundred & Seventy five Dollars for his services as such together with the cost of postage & stationery.
 2. That the Township Officer for the year 1928 be R. N. Tilledt, and he is hereby appointed. Thereof and shall receive the sum of forty Dollars (\$40.00) for his services as officers.
 3. That Charles Graham be and is hereby appointed Sanitary Inspector and Member of the Board of Health for the year 1928 & shall receive at the rate of 35¢ per hour for his services as such Officer, also other officers for work.
 4. That 1st. Neil Shortreed and 2nd Norman Wade, be and are hereby appointed Auditors for the year 1928. to audit the Township accounts and shall receive the sum of (\$25.00) Twenty five Dollars Each for their services as such.
 5. That G. A. Hamilton be and is hereby appointed Collector for the Collection of Taxes for the Corporation for the year 1928, and shall receive the sum of One Hundred and fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for his services as such.
 6. That all Bylaws or Parts of Bylaws inconsistent with this Bylaw be and are hereby repealed.

By Law To Authorize The Borrowing of money to meet current ordinary expenditure for the year 1928.

Whereas it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Ywillimbury to borrow the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars to meet the current ordinary expenditures of the Corporation for the year until Taxes are paid.

And whereas the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section 319 of the Consolidated Municipal Act, 1922, being 12-13 Geo. V., Chapter 72 (Ontario), and amending Acts. Be it therefore enacted as a Bylaw by the said Council as follows

1. That the Head and the Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from the Bank of Nova Scotia on the note of the Corporation, or by way of Overdraft, or otherwise, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000⁰⁰) until such time as the Taxes levied, or to be levied, shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.
2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and Treasurer and the Bank.
3. That the Head and the Treasurer may draw, make and deliver promissory notes, Bills or other securities and documents as may be agreed on, to secure the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By Law.
4. That the Head and the Treasurer may enter into an agreement with the said Bank, sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and Treasurer, providing for the borrowing of the said sum by the said Corporation, and the repayment of the same on or before the last business day of the current year, together with all other terms relating to such borrowing and repayment as the said Head and Treasurer may deem necessary.

a By Law to Authorize the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury to Borrow certain sums to meet the now current expenditure.

Whereas the Taxes levied for the current expenditure of the said Corporation for the year have not yet been fully collected. There being uncollected of such Taxes a sum not less than the sum hereby authorized to borrow. And whereas the sum of Ten thousand Dollars is required to meet the now current expenses of the said Corporation. and it is expedient to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow the said sum;

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury as follows.

1. That the Head. with the Treasurer of the said Corporation be, and they are hereby authorized, under the seal of the Corporation to borrow from the Standard Bank of Canada the sum of Ten thousand Dollars required to meet the now current expenditure of the said Corporation.
2. That the said Head with the Treasurer aforesaid. be, and they are hereby authorized to pay or allow the said Bank interest on the said sum so borrowed at the rate of 6 Per Cent per annum.
3. That a promissory note or notes covenant or agreement. sealed with the Corporation seal. and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Reeve and Treasurer. be duly executed and given to the said Bank as aforesaid as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed. with interest thereon as aforesaid.
4. That the Standard Bank of Canada be and is hereby appointed Banker of the Corporation and is hereby authorized to pay and honor all cheques and orders for payment of money made. signed or drawn in the name of the said Corporation by the ~~Reeve~~ Treasurer and further. to accept for deposits to the Credit of the Corporation all Cheques. drafts. notes. Bills and other negotiable instruments endorsed in the name of the said Corporation by the ~~Reeve~~ Treasurer.

By Law No 799.

A By Law to provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of North Gwillimbury during the year 1928.

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on Township roads under the Highway Improvement Act and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By Law.

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enact as follows:-

1. The sum of \$15000. is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levies for expenditure upon construction and maintenance on the roads in the said Township during the year 1928.

as follows:-

Road Construction	\$4400.
Bridge	3000.
Machinery	800.
Superintendence	800.
Maintenance & Repair	6000.
Total Estimated Expenditure	\$15000.

2. The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Township Road Superintendent.
3. All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting Township roads issued by the Department of Public Highways of Ontario.
4. The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this By Law to the Deputy Minister, Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within thirty days after the passing thereof.

By Law No 801.

A By Law to provide for the appointing of a Road Superintendent for the Township of N. Gwillimbury in the County of York.

Whereas it is desirable that the laying out and supervision of all work & expenditure upon improvement & maintenance of roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of this Township should be under the supervision of a road Supt. acting under the direction of this Council and whereas it is desirable of this Council to take advantage of the Highway Improvement Act & to receive the Government Grant as provided in Sec 43 & 45 of said Act. Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the said Township of N. Gwillimbury & it is hereby enacted.

1. That Carson Pollock, Keswick is appointed road Supt. in the said Township to act as aforesaid in accordance with the provisions of the said Sect 45 of the said Act from the 13th day of April 1928 & during the pleasure of the Council.
2. That the said Carson Pollock shall be paid at the rate of \$4.50 per Day for such time as he may be so employed.
3. That it shall be the duty of the Supt. to lay out & supervise all work & expenditure on roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Township Council & to conform to such general regulations as the Dept. of Public Highways may prescribe.
4. That all By Laws or parts thereof & all or any resolutions of said Council contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith.
5. That the same are hereby repealed.

That a certified copy of this By Law be forwarded by the Clerk without delay to the Deputy Minister, Dept. Public Highways, Toronto, Can.

By Law No 802.

A By Law to provide for the assessing and levying of Taxes for County and Township purposes, Street Lights, Oiling of roads, as well as other special purposes as the law provides whereas power is given Municipal Councils by the Consolidated Municipal Act to Levy and Collect Taxes for all purposes necessary and above mentioned.

That There be levied and collected on all rateable property on the assessment Roll for the year 1928 the sum of \$27059.64 being at the rate of 15 $\frac{3}{10}$ Mills on the Dollar.

That is to say raised for County purposes the sum of \$16535.86 Dollars being at the rate of 9 $\frac{3}{10}$ Mills on the Dollar.

Also for Township purposes the sum of \$4450.50 Dollars being at the rate of 2 $\frac{5}{10}$ Mills on the Dollar.

For the Breckon Bridge debentures the sum of \$1246.14 being at the rate of 7 $\frac{1}{10}$ Mills on the Dollars.

The Special Tax for oiling the roads from Keswick to Jacksons Pt. & where otherwise necessary. being the sum of \$2546.00 being at the rate of 3 $\frac{7}{10}$ Mills on the Dollar.

Special Tax for Street Lights in Keswick for the sum of \$140.80. Dollars being at the rate of 2 Mills on the Dollar.

Special Tax for Collection of Garbage from Rays Corner Roaches Pt. to 4th Concessions being an amount of \$168.00 Dollars at rate of \$300 Per Cottage.

Also from Royers Crossing to Keswick Beach being an amount of \$347.76 Dollars at rate of \$216 per Cottage.
