A By-law to authorize the borrowing of \$ 25,000.⁰⁰

Whereas the Council of the *Township of North Gwillimbury* (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 25,000.⁰⁰ to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

NOTE.—Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 1935, not including revenues derivable or derived from arrears of taxes, borrowings and issues of debentures is \$ 51,000.⁰⁰

~~And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 1935, not including revenues derivable or derived from arrears of taxes, borrowings and issues of debentures is \$ 51,000.⁰⁰~~

Therefore the Council of the **Township** of **North Gwillimbury** hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$
to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of the said section 334, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding **5½** per centum per annum.
2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said section 334, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

FOR ORDINARY EXPENDITURE—ONTARIO }

BY-LAW No. 941

TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF MONEY TO MEET CURRENT
EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of
the Township of North Gwillimbury to borrow an
amount not at any time to exceed the sum of Fifteen thousand
dollars
to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation
for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due
within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates pur-
poses and for meeting the requirements of any Board, Commission or body and other
purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

AND WHEREAS the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and
outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to
be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section
334 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 233, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1927 as amended
by the Municipal Amendment Act, ~~1932 (22 George V, Chapter 29, Section 12)~~

1933.
BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-law by the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of Fifteen thousand dollars until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.
2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and Treasurer and the said Bank.
3. That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-law the Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and/or other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.
4. That all the revenues of the said Corporation of whatsoever nature and kind be and the same are hereby charged to and in favour of the said Bank for and with the payment of any sum borrowed under this By-law and the interest thereon as hereinbefore provided.
5. That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required by the said Bank.

Be By. Law appointing a road superintendent for the Township of North Guilimbery County of York.

Whereas it is described that the laying out and supervision of all work and expenditure upon improvement and maintenance of roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of this Township shall be under the supervision of a road superintendent acting under the direction of this Council,

And whereas it is the desire of this Council to take advantage of the highway improvement Act and to receive the government grant as provided in section 43 & 45 of the said Act,

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of North Guilimbery and it is hereby enacted,

That Carson Pollock is appointed Road superintendent in the said Township to act as in accordance with the provisions of the said Act. Sec 45 of the said Act from the 13th day of January 1936, and during the pleasure of the said Council,

That the said Carson Pollock shall be paid at the rate of \$400 per day for such time as he may be employed
That it shall be the duty of the superintendent to lay out and supervise all work and expenditure on the roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Township Council and to conform to such general regulations as the department of public highways may prescribe,

That all By. Laws or parts of thereof and all or any resolutions of said Council contrary thereto or inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed,

That a certified copy of this By. Law be forwarded by the Clerk without delay to the Deputy Minister Department of Highways, Toronto.

By-Law No. 945

By-Law to regulate traffic on the lake shore road in the Township of North Guilimbury

whereas by the Municipal Act of Ontario councils of all municipalities are empowered to pass By-Laws for regulating traffic on highways,

And whereas the lake shore road of the Township of North Guilimbury from Keswick to Sutton passes through a summer resort area and during the summer months the traffic is congested and the ordinary speed of traffic is dangerous to children and other persons,

And whereas it is desirable to regulate the speed on the said highway,

Therefore the municipal council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilimbury enacts as follows,

1 No person shall operate a motor car or vehicle on that part of the highway known as the lakeshore road from a point at the intersection of the said lakeshore road with the county highway at Keswick to a point in the said lakeshore road where it joins the village of Sutton, at a greater rate of speed than twenty miles per hour during the months of May, June, July, August and September in each and every year.

2 Every person who is guilty of a contravention of this By-Law shall incur a penalty not exceeding Fifty Dollars, (\$50.00) exclusive of costs, and in case of non-payment of the fine and costs, the same may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender, and in case of non-payment of the fine and costs and there being no distress found out of which the same can be levied such offender shall be liable to be imprisoned in the common goal of the County of York with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding twenty-one days.

3 Nothing in this By-Law shall in any way diminish the restrictions as established by any other By-Law of the said Township, which may affect any portion of the highways hereinbefore described,

4 This By-Law shall take effect on the receiving of the approval by the department of highways of the Province of Ontario,

A. By Law to authorize the construction of a gravel pre-mix asphalt road surface on the lake shore Road in the Township of North Gwillimbury from Keswick to Jackson's Point (Sutton) at a cost of \$26,000.00 and to provide for borrowing \$15,600.00 upon debentures to pay the Township's share of the cost.

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury deems it expedient to construct a gravel pre-mix asphalt road surface on the lake shore Road in the Township of North Gwillimbury from Keswick to Jackson's Point (Sutton) at a total cost of \$26,000.00 of which sixty per cent (60%) is to be paid by the Township of North Gwillimbury, and forty per cent (40%) or \$10,400.00 is to be provided otherwise,

And whereas it is necessary to borrow the sum of \$15,600.00 upon the credit of the Corporation to pay the Corporation's portion of the cost of the aforesaid work,

And whereas the amount of the whole rateable property of the Corporation according to the last revised assessment Roll is \$2,028,800.00,

And whereas the amount of the existing debenture debt of the Corporation exclusive of local improvements debts secured by special rates or assessments, is \$2,000.00 and no part of the principal or interest is in arrears,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows,

That the Reeve and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and instructed (subject to the approval of this Council by By. Law) to enter into a contract for the construction of a gravel pre-mix asphalt road surface on the lake shore road, surface on lake shore Road in the Township of North Gwillimbury from Keswick to Jackson's Point (Sutton) at a cost of \$26,000.00.
