A By-Law appointing a Road Superintendent in the Township of North Gwillimbury in the County of York.

Whereas it is desirable that the laying out and supervision of all work and expenditure upon improvement and maintenance of roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of this Township should be under the direction of a road superintendent acting under the direction of the Council.

And whereas it is the desire of this Council to take advantage of the Highway Improvement Act and to receive the Government grant as provided in R. S. O. 1937, Chapter 56, Section 45, 47 and 49.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the said Township and it is hereby enacted:

(1) That Angus J. King of North Gwillimbury is appointed Road Superintendent of the said Township to act as aforesaid in accordance with the provisions of the said Section 45 of the said Act from the first day of January 1940 and during the pleasure of the Council.

(2) That the Road Superintendent shall be paid at the rate of \$900⁰⁰ Dollars per year for such time as he may be so employed, Payable in equal monthly installments.

(3) That it shall be the duty of the Superintendent to lay out and supervise all work and expenditures on roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Township Council and to conform to such general regulations as the Department of Highways may prescribe.

(4) That all By-Laws or parts thereof and all or any resolutions of the said Council contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

(5) That a certified copy of this By-Law be forwarded by the Clerk without delay to the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, Toronto.

By-Law No 1004

A By-Law to provide for the total 1940 expenditure on roads in the Township of North Gwillimbury in the County of York.

Whereas the Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 56 R.S.O. 1937 and amendments requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by Township by-law.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the said Township enacts as follows

(1) The sum of \$16000⁰⁰ is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads in the said township during the year 1940 as follows

Machinery	\$ 1500 ⁰⁰
Superintendence	\$ 1000 ⁰⁰

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with the latest regulations ~~issued~~ respecting township roads issued by the Department of Highways of Ontario

(3) The clerk shall transmit a copy of this by-law to the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, for approval on or before February 28th of the present year.

BY-LAW No. ~~1004~~ 1006

A By-law to authorize the borrowing of \$ 30,000

Whereas the Council of the Township of North Gwillimbury (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 30,000 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

NOTE.—Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 1939, not including revenues derivable or derived from arrears of taxes, borrowings and issues of debentures, is \$ 65,000.

(Delete this paragraph if not applicable).

~~And Whereas the total amount hereof authorized to be borrowed this year for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of section 339 of the Municipal Act is \$ of which the Municipality has already borrowed a total of \$~~

Therefore the Council of the Township of North Gwillimbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$ 30,000 to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of section 339 of the Municipal Act, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding five per centum per annum.
2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law, as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said section 339, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

AGREEMENT WITH MUNICIPALITY }
BORROWING BY PROMISSORY NOTE }

AGREEMENT

made this Eleventh day of January A.D. 19 40,

BETWEEN THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION of the Township
of North Guilford hereinafter called the "CORPORATION,"

OF THE ONE PART,

and

THE BANK OF NOVA SCOTA, hereinafter called the "BANK,"

OF THE OTHER PART.

WHEREAS by a By-law passed by the Council of the Corporation on the Eleventh day of January authority was given to the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation to borrow from the Bank the moneys therein mentioned, and by such by-law this agreement was authorized.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation desires to borrow the said moneys on its promissory notes and the Bank in consideration of the execution of this agreement by the Corporation has consented thereto subject to and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED that the said moneys may be borrowed by the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation from the Bank upon the promissory notes of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation.

IT IS ALSO AGREED that any moneys advanced to the Corporation from time to time upon such promissory notes shall bear interest at the rate of not more than five per cent. per annum which shall be added at the end of each month to the amount advanced up to that time, and when added shall for the purpose of computing subsequent interest be deemed to be part of the advance.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Corporation shall repay the moneys so advanced with accrued interest at the rate aforesaid on such date as shall be agreed with the Bank and in any event not later than the 31st day of December next ensuing.

As security for repayment of the moneys so advanced by the Bank with interest as aforesaid, all the revenues of the Corporation of whatever nature and kind are hereby charged to and in favour of the Bank, and the Bank shall have a lien upon all such revenues until the charge hereby and by said by-law created is satisfied.

ORDINARY EXPENDITURE—ONTARIO }

BY-LAW No. 1008

TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF MONEY TO MEET CURRENT
EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of
the Township of North Simsbury to borrow an
amount not at any time to exceed the sum of

Ten Thousand dollars
to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation
for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due
within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates pur-
poses and for meeting the requirements of any Board, Commission or body and other
purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

AND WHEREAS the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and
outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to
be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section
339 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 266, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1937.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-law by the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized
to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of

Ten Thousand dollars
until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.

2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time
as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and
Treasurer and the said Bank.

3. That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-law the
Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and/or
other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the
seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.

4. That all the revenues of the said Corporation of whatsoever nature and kind be and the
same are hereby charged to and in favour of the said Bank for and with the payment of any sum
borrowed under this By-law and the interest thereon as hereinbefore provided.

5. That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement
or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Cor-
poration by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and
the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such
other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required
by the said Bank.

Whereas the Municipal Act requires Municipal Councils to assess and collect for all Taxes above mentioned during the current year.
