A By-Law to appoint a Clerk & Treasurer
an Assessor, a Collector, Two Auditors
and a Board of Health, also a Medical
Health Officer, a Sanitary Inspector
and a Pound keeper for the Village
of Sutton for the Current year

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council
of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton
and it is hereby enacted by the authority
of the same

1st That Peter McCellan be and
is hereby appointed Clerk & Treasurer

2nd That H. Zelvar be and is hereby
appointed Assessor

3rd That John Donnell be and is
hereby appointed Collector

4th That John R. Bouchier and
Anna Fry be and are hereby appointed
Auditors

5th That Robert Nicol, Henry Berry
and James Abbie and the Reeve
and Clerk be and are hereby con-
stituted The Board of Health with
Dr. J. B. Bentley as Medical Health
Officer and Amos Willard as
Sanitary Inspector

6th And for the due performance of the duties of said Offices they shall receive as follows

The Clerk and Treasurer	\$ 60 ⁰⁰
The Assessor	\$ 15 ⁰⁰
The Collector	\$ 20 ⁰⁰
The Auditors each	\$ 2 ⁰⁰

7th And that the Treasurer furnish to this Council satisfactory security to the amount of \$2000⁰⁰

8th And that Henry Berry be and is hereby appointed Pound Keeper

By-Law No 30

a By-Law to provide for the Levying of County, School, R. Road and Village rates for the Corporation of the Village of Sutton for the year 1893.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

that the following rates be levied and collected upon all the ratable property of the said Village of Sutton for the year A.D. 1893 for the purposes hereinafter set forth viz:

- 1st For County General Purpose and Industrial Home a rate of $1\frac{1}{10}$ mills on the \$
- 2nd For Village purposes a rate of $4\frac{4}{10}$ Mills on the \$
- 3rd For County & Township R. Road Debentures a rate of 3 mills on the \$
- 4th For Union School Section No 1 of Sutton and Georgina as per School Board's request a rate of $5\frac{5}{10}$ mills on the \$
- 5th For Debentures for School House a rate of $1\frac{7}{10}$ Mills on the \$

6th That the rates imposed by this By-Law shall be collected and paid over to the Treasurer of this Corporation in bank-able funds on or before the 15th day of November 1893 by the Collector of rates for the said Village of Sutton in so far as the law will enable him to do

By-Law No 31

a By-Law to authorize and empower the Reeve and Treasurer of the Village of Sutton to borrow a certain sum to meet the current expenditure of the Village

Whereas it is necessary to make provision by way of a temporary loan for the purpose of providing funds to defray the ordinary expenditure of the Village

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

^{1st} That the Reeve and Treasurer be and are hereby authorized and empowered under the seal of this Corporation to obtain a loan from the Bank or from any person in such a manner as may be in the best interest of this Village said loan not to exceed Two hundred dollars and to be repaid on or before the 15th day of December next

By-Law No 32

A By-Law to provide a place for holding the nomination for a Reeve and four Councillors for the Village of Sutton and for providing a Polling place for holding the Municipal Election and Plebiscite Vote for the year 1894.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

1st That Sheppard's Hall be and is hereby provided as a place for holding the nomination of Reeve and Councillors for the said Village of Sutton for the year 1894, and also as a place for holding the Municipal Election and Plebiscite Vote for the Village of Sutton for the year 1894.

2nd That Peter McClellan Clerk be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer for said Municipal Election and Plebiscite Vote
