Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

1st That Peter McClellan be and is hereby appointed Clerk and Treasurer

2nd That John Cornwall be and is hereby appointed Assessor

3rd That Henry Treloar be and is hereby appointed Collector

4th That John R. Bourchier and Mrs Fry be and are hereby appointed Auditors

5th That Robert Nicol, Richard Dalton, A. S. Anderson and The Reeve and Clerk be and are hereby appointed and constituted the Local Board of Health with T. B. Bentley M.D. as Medical Health Officer and H. A. Kemp as Sanitary Inspector

6th And for the due performance of the duties of said Offices they shall receive as follows

The Collector	\$ 20.00
The Auditors each	\$ 2.00

7th And that the Treasurer furnish to this Council satisfactory security to the amount of \$2000.00

8th And that Henry Perry be and is hereby appointed Town Keeper

9th And that section one of By-Law no 28 be and hereby is amended by striking out the name of Peter Grant and inserting in lieu thereof the name of H. A. Kempf

A By. Law to authorize and empower the Reeve and Treasurers of the Village of Sutton to borrow a certain sum of money to meet the current expenditure of the Village for the present year

Whereas it is necessary to make provision by way of a temporary loan for the purpose of providing funds to defray the ordinary expenditure of the Village

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the said Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

1894 That the Reeve and Treasurers be and are hereby authorized and empowered under the seal of this Corporation to obtain a loan from the Bank or from any person in such a manner as may be in the best interests of the Village; said loan not to exceed two hundred and fifty dollars and to be repaid on or before the fifteenth day of December next

A. By-Law to provide for the Levying of County, School, W. Road and Village rates for the Corporation of the Village of Sutton for the year 1894 A. D.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

That the following rates be levied and collected upon all the rateable property of the said Village of Sutton for the year A. D. 1894 for the purposes hereinafter set forth viz:-

- 1st For County General Purpose and Industrial House a rate of $1\frac{1}{10}$ mills on the \$
- 2nd For Township W. Road Debentures a rate of 2 mills on the \$
- 3rd For Village Purposes a rate of $4\frac{4}{10}$ mills on the \$
- 4th For Union School Section No 1 of Sutton and Georgia as per School Boards request a rate of 5 mills on the \$
- 5th For Debentures for School House a rate of $1\frac{7}{10}$ mills on the \$

6th That the rates imposed by this By-Law shall be collected and paid to the Treasurer of this Corporation in Bankable Funds on or before the 15th day of November A. D. 1894 by the Collector of rates for the said Village of Sutton in so far as the law will enable him so to do
