

By-Law No. 64

A By-Law to Appoint a Clerk, a Treasurer, an assessor, a Collector, two Auditors, two Poundkeepers, three Fence viewers, a Village Constable, one Member of the Board of Health, a Medicine Health Officer, a Sanitary Inspector and a Street Officer for the Village of Sutton for the Current Year (1898)

Be it therefore enacted and it is hereby by the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

1st That J. G. Brown be and is hereby appointed Clerk

2nd That R. Sturtevant be and is hereby appointed Treasurer

3rd That George Cuttle be and is hereby appointed assessor

4th That Richard Burch be and is hereby appointed Collector

5th That A. Crozier (Elected) and J. Fry appointed by Resol be and are hereby appointed Auditors

6th That Simpson Horner and Robt Moore be and are hereby appointed Pound Keepers

7th That Amos Millard, Richard Burch and Simpson Horner be and are hereby appointed Fence Viewers

- 8th - That Richard Burch be and is hereby appointed a Member of the Board of Health for a period of Three (3) Years, who with those Members whose terms of Membership have not expired, together with the Nurse and Clerk shall constitute the Local Board of Health for the Current Year with Dr. C. J. Noble as Medical Health Officer and Dr. E. Sheppard as Sanitary Inspector.
- 9th That Dr. E. Sheppard be and is hereby appointed Inmate Officer and Village Constable.
- 10th - That the following officers shall receive payment for the due and proper performance of the duties of their several offices as follows:
- The Clerk - Thirty Dollars
 The Treasurer - Twelve $\frac{50}{100}$ Dollars
 The Assessor - Fifteen Dollars
 The Collector - Twenty Dollars
 Each Auditor - Two Dollars
- over and above the fees provided by the Statutes for certain services.
- 11th That the Treasurer and Collector shall each separately furnish to this Council Satisfactory Security to the amount of - Two Thousand Dollars.
- 12th That all other By-Laws and parts of By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By Law No. 67.

A. By Law. To provide for the levying of County, School, School Districts and Village Rates for the year 1898.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton, and it is hereby enacted by Authority of the same

1st That the following rate be levied, and collected, upon all the taxable property within the Village of Sutton for the year 1898. for the purposes herein after set forth

2nd For County General purposes, and in duplicate & Home at rate 1 $\frac{4}{10}$ Mills on the Dollar.

3rd For Village purposes a rate of 4 Mills on the Dollar.

4th For Union School Section No. 1. Sutton and Weyburn, as per School Boards request a rate of 5 $\frac{4}{10}$ Mills on the Dollar.

5th For Village share of School Debentures
a rate of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ % Mills on the Dollar.

6th That the rates imposed by this By-Law
shall be collected, and paid to the
Treasurer of this Corporation, in
bankable funds on or before the
Fifteenth day of December 1898. by
the collector of Rates for the said Village
of Sutton, in so far as the law
enables him to do.

By Law No 68.

To close up an original allowance for a Lane, situated in Block number 68, in the Village of Sutton, as shown on a Map or Plan of the said Village of Sutton Registered as No. 69

1.st Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton.

That whereas John Staley and others have petitioned this Council, to close up an original allowance for a Lane, — hereinafter set forth and described.

2.nd And whereas Public Notice, has been given as required by the Municipal Act of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, as per annexed Exhibits, of the intention of this Council to pass a By-Law for closing up the said original allowance for Lane, and all persons whose lands might be prejudicially affected thereby, have been heard, who petitioned to be so heard.

3.rd And whereas this Council has determined and agreed to close up the said Lane original allowance for a Lane, — hereinafter described

By-Law No. 68. continued

4th Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton. That the original allowance for same, comprising all and singular that parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being, in the Village of Sutton, in the County of York and Province of Ontario, and running East and West fifteen and a half feet wide between lot number one to six on the North side thereof, and lot number seven to fifteen, on the South side of the said Lane there being the original numbers of the said lots as per Map or Plan of the said Village of Sutton by W. C. Yarnold dated 16th July 1842 and registered in the Registry office in the North Riding of the County of York as No. 69. And which Lane is further described and shown on a Plan of the East part of Block No. 68 in the said Village of Sutton, made by - - - W. C. Yarnold and filed in the above - mentioned Registry office on the 31st May 1846 as No. 79. as running between lot number seven, eight, three and eight, two on the South side of the said Lane, and lot number eight, four, number three, two and one on the North side thereof. Be and the same is hereby stopped up and closed.

Of Persons all Jats, and them open all the Streets, and Lanes, on the property facing Sandy Beach, known as the Bateem property, situate in the Village of Sutton Lane and except a Lane, closed up by By. Law No 8 passed November 1st 1898.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton

That whereas application has been made to this Council by R. P. Coulson and others, praying that a By Law may be passed for the Removal of all Jats, and the opening of all Streets and Lanes, situate in Block 68, in the Village of Sutton, on the property known as the Bateem property hereafter set forth and described.

1st - And whereas Public Notice (as per Exhibit attached hereto), has been given of the intention of this Council to pass a By Law, authorizing the removal of the said Jats &c., and all persons whose lands might be prejudicially affected thereby, have been heard, who petitioned to be so heard.

2^d. Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton. That all the gates and obstructions on the Street, being North and South, between Lot number One to Twelve on the East side thereof, and Lot number Sixteen to Twenty One on the West side of the said Street, and on the Lane running East and West, between Lot number Twenty Two, on the South side thereof and Lot number, Twenty Three to Twenty Nine on the North side of the said Lane, all of which Street, Lane and Lot, are situate lying and being in the Village of Sutton, in the County of York and Province of Ontario, being — comprised of part of Block number 68. in the said Village of Sutton, as shown and described on a Map or Plan thereof, made by W. C. Yarnold, and Registered in the Registry Office for the North Riding of the County of York as No 69. Be amended and the Street and Lanes open and established for Public use. Save and except a Lane closed by By Law No 68. Passed November 1st 1898. as before mentioned
