A. By Law to provide for the levying of  
County, School, School Distinctives,  
and Village Rate for the year 1899

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal  
Council of the Village of Sutton, and  
it is hereby enacted by authority of the  
same.

1<sup>st</sup> That the following rates be levied, and  
collected upon all the taxable property  
within the Village of Sutton for the year  
1899, for the purposes herein after  
set forth.

2<sup>nd</sup> For County General purposes a rate of  
 $1\frac{3}{10}$  Mills, and Industrial bond  
a rate of  $3\frac{1}{10}$  Mills on the dollar

3<sup>rd</sup> For Village purposes a rate of 4  
Mills on the dollar

4<sup>th</sup> For Union School Section No. 1  
Sutton and Georgia on per School  
Board Requirement a rate of  $4\frac{7}{10}$   
Mills on the dollar

5<sup>th</sup> For Village share of School Distinctives  
a rate of  $1\frac{4}{10}$  Mills on the dollar

By Law No. 76. continued.

Sept. 6. That the rates imposed by this By Law shall be collected and paid to the Treasurer of Corporation, in Bankable funds, on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December 1899, by the collector of Rates for the said Village of Sutton, in so far as the Law enables him so to do.

2<sup>nd</sup> That J. H. Barnard be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer for the said Municipal Election
