17. By Law to appoint a Clerk, a Treasurer, an Assessor, a Collector, an Auditor, two Poundkeepers, three Justice of the Peace, a Village Constable, one Member of the Board of Health, a Medical Health Officer, a Sanitary Inspector and a Militant Officer for the Village of Sutton for the Current year 1900.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton, and it is hereby enacted by Authority of the same.

1st That J. W. Barnard be and he is hereby appointed Clerk

2nd That Richard Stritidge, be and he is hereby appointed Treasurer

3rd That George Outle, be and he is hereby appointed Assessor

4th That Richard Durak, be and he is hereby appointed Collector

5th That Archibald Cronie and William Joy be and they are hereby appointed Auditors

6th That Simpson Horner and Peter Bank, be and they are hereby appointed Port Keepers

7th That Archibald Purch, A. Mollard and Simpson Horner be and they are hereby appointed Trustees

8th That Mrs Mollard be and is hereby appointed a member of the Board of Health for a period of 3 years, who with those members, whose term of ~~office~~ ^{office} have not expired, together with the Reeve and Clerk, shall constitute the Local Board of Health for the current year (1907) with A. B. Greenwood M. D. as Medical Health Officer, and G. E. Sheppard as Sanitary Inspector.

9th That G. E. Sheppard be and he is hereby appointed Town Officer and Wing Constable.

10. That the following Officers shall receive Salaries for the due and proper performance of the duties of their several offices as follows
 viz. The Clerk. Thirty Dollars.
 " Treasurer. Fifteen Dollars.
 " Assessor. Fifteen Dollars.
 " Collector. Twenty Dollars.
 Each Auditor Two Dollars.
 The Steward of the Fire. Five Dollars.
 And above the fees provided by the Statutes for certain services.

11. That the Treasurer and Collector shall each, severally furnish to this Council satisfactory security to the amount of Two Thousand Dollars.

12. That all other By Laws or parts of By Laws, inconsistent with this By Law, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Al. By Law to provide for the Paying of County, School Taxes, and Village Rates for the year 1900

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Committee of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton, and it is hereby enacted by Authority of the same

1st That the following Rate be levied and collected, upon all the rateable Property within the Village of Sutton for the year 1900. for the purposes hereinafter set forth.

2nd For the County General purposes a Rate of $1\frac{4}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar and for the Instructed Home a Rate of $3\frac{1}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar

3rd For the Village purposes a Rate of 4 Mills in the Dollar

4th For Union School Section No. 1. Sutton and vicinity as per Schools Boards request a Rate of $4\frac{8}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar.

5th That the Rates imposed by this By Law shall be collected, and paid to the Treasurer of this
