A By Law to provide for a place for holding the nomination and Election of a Reeve and four Councillors for the Village of Sutton for the year 1904

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same-

1st That the Queen's Hotel Hall be and is hereby provided as a place for holding the nomination and Election of Reeve and four Councillors for the aforesaid Village of Sutton for the year 1904 in accordance with the Statutes.

2nd. That J. G. Lemayne be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer for the said Municipal Election.

{ The Constable, Sanitary Inspector & Street Officer	Twenty	dollars

over and above the fees provided by the statutes for certain services

That the Treasurer and Collector shall each severally furnish to the Council satisfactory security to the amount of Two Thousand dollars -

That all other By-Laws or parts of By-Laws inconsistent with this By Law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-Law No 96

A By-Law to provide for the levying of County Debenture Debt and Village Rates for the Village of Sutton for the year 1904

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same

That the following rates be levied and collected upon all the rateable property within the Village of Sutton for the year 1904 for the purposes hereinafter set forth

- 1 For the County General Purposes a rate of $1\frac{1}{8}$ Mill in the Dollar.
- 2 For Union School Section No 1 Sutton and Georgina a rate of 6 Mills in the Dollar.
- 3 For Town Hall debentures a rate of $1\frac{1}{2}$ Mill in the Dollar.
- 4 For Village Purposes a rate of 5 Mills in the Dollar.
- 5 That the rates imposed by this By-Law shall be collected and paid to the Treasurer of this Corporation in Bankable Funds on or before the 15th day of December 1904 by the Collector of Rates for the said Village of Sutton in so far as the law enables him so to do.
