6th

That Amos Millard and R. Burch be and hereby appointed Fence Viewers.

7th

That W. E. Sheppard be and is hereby appointed Village Constable, Truant Officer and Sanitary Inspector.

8th

That R. Burch be and is hereby appointed a Member of the Board of Health for three years.

9th

That the Officers shall receive payment for the due and proper performance of their several offices as follows-

The Clerk Forty five Dollars
 The Treasurer Fifteen "
 The Collector Twenty Five "
 Each Auditor Two and a half "
 The Constable, Sanitary Inspector and
 Treadmill Officer Thirty Dollars

That the Treasurer and Collector shall each severally furnish to the Council satisfactory security to the amount of \$1200⁰⁰

That all other By-Laws or parts of By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed -

Whereas it is requisite to provide certain funds for necessary expenses of the Village of Sutton by way of loan said loan to be repaid out of the rates of 1905

Be it therefore enacted by the Corporation of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same -

That the Reeve and Treasurer of the Village of Sutton be authorized and directed to raise by way of loan an amount not exceeding \$200⁰⁰ from any party or parties willing to loan the same -

By Law No 101

A By-Law to provide for the levying of County, Debt, School and Village Rates for the Village of Sutton for the year 1905

Be it therefore enacted by The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same -

That the following rates be levied and collected upon all the rateable property within the Village of Sutton for the year 1905 for the purposes hereinafter set forth

- 1 For the County General Purposes, Debt and Industrial Home a rate of 1.2 Mills on the dollar
- 2 For Union School Section No 1 Sutton and Georgina a rate of 4.8 Mills on the dollar
- 3 For Town Hall Debt a rate of 1.1 Mills on the dollar
- 4 For Village General Purposes a rate of 5.5 Mills on the dollar
- 5 That the rates imposed by this By-Law shall be collected and paid to the Treasurer of this Corporation in Payable Funds on or before the 15th day of December 1905 by the Collector of Rates for the said Village of Sutton in so far as the Law enables him so to do.
