By Law No 106

A By Law to provide for Levying
County, School, Deventure and
Village Rates for the Village
of Sutton for the year 1906

Be it enacted by the Municipal
Council of the Village of Sutton

That the following rates be levied
and collected upon all the
taxable property within the
Village of Sutton for the year
1906 for the purposes herein
after set forth.

For the County General Purposes
Deventure and Industrial Home
a rate of $1\frac{2}{10}$ mills on the dollar

For Union School Section No 1 Sutton
and Georgia a rate of $4\frac{5}{10}$ mills
in the dollar.

For Town Hall Deventure a rate of 1 mill.

For Village General Purposes a rate of 5 mills in the dollar

That the rates imposed by this By Law shall be
collected and paid to the Treasurer of this Corporation
in Bannock Funds on or before the 15th day of
December 1906 by the Collector in so far as the
law enables him so to do.
