A By-Law to appoint Officers for the Village of Sutton for the year 1908

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton

- 1st That F. G. Lemayne be and is hereby appointed Clerk,
- 2nd That R. Sturtridge be and is hereby appointed Treasurer.
- 3rd That Geo Cuttle be and is hereby appointed Treasurer.
- 4th That John McDonald be and is hereby appointed Collector.
- 5th That D. H. Hoole be and is hereby appointed Medical Health Officer.
- 6th That W. Stolborn be and is hereby appointed a Member of the Board of Health.
- 7th That Peter Grant and Amos Millard be and hereby appointed Fence Viewers.
- 8th That Peter Grant and Adolph. Charpentier be and are hereby appointed Pound Keepers -
- 9th That W. C. Sheppard be and is hereby appointed Constable, Squent Officer and Sanitary Inspector.
- 10th That A. Crozier and Wm Fry be and are hereby appointed Auditors.
- 11th That each Officer shall receive for the due and proper performance of his duties as follows

By-Law no 114

A By-Law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer of the Village of Sutton to borrow certain sums to meet the current expenditures of the said Village.

Whereas it is necessary to make provision by way of temporary loans to defray the ordinary expenditures of the Village. Be it therefore enacted by the authority of the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton.

That the Reeve and Treasurer be empowered under the seal of the Corporation to negotiate a loan or loans with any person, persons or corporation in such manner as may be in the interest of the Village for such sums or sums as may be necessary not to exceed in the whole the sum of nine hundred dollars and to be repaid on or before the 15th day of December 1908.

By-Law No 115

A By-Law to provide for Levying County School, Adventure and Village Rates for the year 1908

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton, that the following rates be levied and collected upon all the rateable property within the Village of Sutton for the year 1908 for the purposes hereinafter set forth

For County General Purposes, Adventure and Industrial Home a rate of $1\frac{3}{10}$ mills in the Dollar

For Union School Section No 1 Sutton and Georgina a rate of 5 mills in the Dollar

For Town Hall Adventure a rate of 1 mill in the Dollar

For Village General Purposes a rate of $5\frac{5}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar

That the rates imposed by this By-Law shall be collected and paid to the Treasurer of this Corporation in Bankable Funds on or before the 15th day of December 1908 by the Collector in so far as the law will enable him so to do.
