

By Law No 264
 A By Law to appoint certain officers
 for the Village of Sutton for
 the year 1917

Be it enacted by the Municipal
 Council of the Village of Sutton

That S. D. Sennett be appointed Assessor

That J. H. Leloir be appointed Collector

That R. J. Norman and R. Sturbridge be
 appointed Auditors

That A. Millard and Hector Cameron
 be appointed Fence Viewers

That W. E. Sheppard and Wth Conner be
 appointed Pound Keepers.

That W. E. Sheppard be appointed
 Constable, Sanitary Inspector and Quack
 Officer.

That Dr C. J. Noble and Dr Lavery be
 appointed a Board of Health.

That Dr C. J. Noble be appointed Medical
 Health Officer

That each officer shall receive for
 the due performance of his office
 in addition to certain fees provided
 for by statute the following sums

That is to say

The Assessor	\$ 50.00
The Collector	\$ 50.00
Each Auditor	\$ 5.00
Medical Officer of Health	\$ 75.00
Comptroller, Fiscal Officer and Sanitary Inspector	\$ 50.00

That the Collector shall furnish to the Council satisfactory security to the amount of Two Thousand Dollars.

That all By-Laws and parts of By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law be repealed.

By Law No 266

A By Law to provide for levying and collecting
County, School, Debenture, Library and
Village General Purpose Rates for the Village
of Sutton for the year 1917

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council
of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton
that the following shall be levied
and collected upon all the rateable
property of the said Village for
the year 1917

For all County Rates including the Provin-
cial War Tax a rate of $6\frac{6}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar

For General School Rates $6\frac{6}{10}$ Mills in \$

For School Debenture $7\frac{1}{10}$ Mills in \$

For Town Hall Debenture $6\frac{1}{10}$ Mills in \$

For Public Library $3\frac{1}{10}$ Mills in \$

For Village General Purpose $6\frac{2}{10}$ Mills in \$

That the rates imposed by this By Law
shall be paid to the Treasurer of the
Corporation in Bandable Funds on or
before the 15th day of December 1917 by
the Collector in so far as the law will
enable him so to do

Be it further enacted that an
additional five per cent shall be added
to and collected on any taxes imposed
by this By Law which shall not have been
paid to the Collector of said Village before
the 15th day of December 1917
