By Law No 273

A By-Law to provide for levying and collecting County, School, Debt and Library, & Village General Purpose Rates for the Village of Sutton for the year 1918

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton.

That the following rates shall be levied and collected upon all the rateable property of the said Village for the year 1918

- 1 For all County rates including Provincial War Tax of rate of $10\frac{2}{10}$ mills in the Dollar
- 2 For General School Purposes a rate of $7\frac{5}{10}$ mills in the Dollar.
- 3 For School Debt and Library a rate of $\frac{8}{10}$ mill in the Dollar.
- 4 For Town and Hall Debt and Library a rate of $\frac{6}{10}$ mill in the Dollar.
- 5 For Public Library a rate of $\frac{3}{10}$ mill in the Dollar.
- 6 For Village General Purposes a rate of $6\frac{2}{10}$ mills in the Dollar.
- 7 That the rates imposed by this By-Law shall be paid to the Treasurer of this Corporation in Bankable funds on or before the fifteenth day of December 1918 by the Collector in so far as the law will enable him so to do.

8 Be it further enacted that an additional charge of five per cent shall be added to and collected on any taxes imposed by this By-Law which not have been paid to the Collector of said Village before the 15th day of December 1918

By Law No 274

To provide for the early closing of shops
in the Village of Sutton.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council
of the Corporation of the Village of
Sutton

1. That from and after the expiration of
~~expiration~~ ^{seven} days from the final
passing of this By-Law all shops within
the meaning of the Act No 229 R.S.O. shall
close and remain closed from and after
the hour of seven o'clock in the afternoon
until five o'clock on the following morning
on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays
during the months of November, December,
January, February, March, April and May
excepting the week preceding & following
Christmas Day
2. That any person or persons convicted of
any breach of this By-Law shall be liable
to a fine of not less than Five and not more
than Twenty Dollars such fine and costs
of conviction to be recoverable under the
provisions of the Ontario Summary Con-
victions Act

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton:

That F. G. Tremayne be appointed Clerk.

That he shall receive for the due performance of his duties the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars per year over and above certain fees provided for by the Statutes.

That R. T. Shurtridge be appointed Treasurer.

That he shall receive for the due performance of his duties the sum of Sixty Dollars per year.

That the Treasurer shall furnish to this Council satisfactory security to the amount of Two Thousand Dollars.

That all By-Laws or parts of By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law be repealed.
