A By-Law to appoint certain Officers for
the Village of Sutton for the year 1919

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of
the Village of Sutton:

That G. W. Culver will be appointed Assessor

That Jas. H. Telor be appointed Collector

That J. H. Cameron and Amos Millard be
appointed Fence Viewers.

That W^m Comer and W. E. Shepard be
appointed Pound Keepers.

That W. E. Shepard be appointed
Constable, Sanitary Inspector and Treadmill Officer.

That E. J. Noble and E. R. Travis be appointed
a Board of Health.

That E. J. Noble be appointed Medical
Health Officer.

That Rev^d H. E. Moxon be appointed
a member of the Public Library Board.

That each officer shall receive for the
due performance of his Office in
addition to certain fees provided for
by statute the following sums that is
to say -

The Assessor

Sixty Dollars

The Collector Sixty Dollars
 Medical Officer of Health Seventy Five
 Dollars
 Constable, Treasurer and
 Sanitary Inspector Seventy Five Dollars

That the Collector shall furnish to
 the Council satisfactory security
 to the amount of Two Thousand Dollars.

That all By-Laws or parts of By-Laws
 inconsistent with this By-Law be
 repealed.
