LAW No.

A BY-LAW to provide a place for the Nomination and Election of a Reeve and Four Councillors for the Village of Sutton and also for Three Members of the School Board.

Be it enacted by The Corporation of the Village of Sutton.

1st. That the Town hall be provided as a place for holding the Nomination and Election. *That the nomination be held between the hours of 7 o'clock + 8 o'clock PM*

That the Polling Place for the Municipal Voters whose Names begin with the letter A up to the letter M both inclusive shall be the Upper Part of the Town Hall and that

H. C. C. C. C. C. be appointed Deputy Returning Officer and *S. Brown* be appointed Poll Clerk.

That the Polling Place for the Municipal Voters whose names begin with the letter N up to the letter Z both inclusive shall be the Library Room in the Town Hall and that

W. H. Slogden be appointed Deputy Returning Officer and *R. Burnham* be appointed Poll Clerk.

Whereas Chapter 192 Paragraph 398 gives Councils of all municipalities power to pass By-Laws for aiding Amateur Athletic Sports

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton that a certain block of land be purchased from John Abbott said land being lots 1 to 10 inclusive in block 19 Sutton said land when purchased to be used as a Recreation and Play Ground for and by the Village of Sutton under the rules and regulations which the Municipal Council of Sutton may deem requisite and necessary.

That for the price Four Hundred Dollars the Reeve be authorized to draw an order on the Treasurer on completion of the proper conveyance

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton

that the following rates shall be levied and collected upon all the rateable property within the said Village for the year 1920

That the rates imposed by this By Law shall be paid to the Treasurer of this Corporation in Bankable funds on or before the 15th day of December 1920 by the Collector in so far as the law will enable him so to do;

Be it further enacted that an additional charge of five per cent shall be added to and collected on any taxes imposed by this By Law which shall not have been to the Collector of said Village before the 16th day of December 1920
