Be it enacted by the Municipal Council

That Geo W. Culverwell be appointed Assessor

That J. H. Nelson be appointed Collector,

That M. Tremayne & G. Morrison be appointed Auditors

That W. Lore & W. Gomez be appointed Pound Keepers

That W. E. Sheppard be appointed Sanitary Inspector

That J. Flavery Vt be appointed a member of  
the Board of Health.

That D. Noble be appointed Medical  
Officer of Health.

That each officer shall receive for  
the due performance of his office in  
addition to certain fees provided for  
by statute the following sums that  
is to say

" Collector	75 <sup>00</sup>
Each Auditor	15 <sup>00</sup>
Medical Officer of Health	90 <sup>00</sup>
Sanitary Inspector	65 <sup>00</sup>

That the Collector shall furnish to  
the Council satisfactory security  
to the amount of Two Thousand  
Dollars.

That all By Laws and parts of By Laws  
inconsistent with this By Law be re-  
pealed.

To fix a fee for Restaurants  
for the Village of Sutton

Council of Sutton that no person  
shall operate a Restaurant in the  
Village of Sutton without first  
obtaining a License for the same from

a fee of Fifteen Dollars shall be paid.

That said License shall be signed by the  
Treasurer and Clerk and shall  
be prominently displayed in the  
licensed premises.

and are hereby repealed

To prohibit the parking of automobiles on certain portions of streets within the Village of Sutton

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton

- 1 That all parking of automobiles is prohibited on the Lake Shore Road from the West Limit of Town Line to the Grand Trunk Track East

That any person or persons convicted of a breach of this By-Law shall be liable to a fine of not less than Five or more than Ten Dollars in the discretion of the Convicting Justice and that all the provisions of the Summary Conviction Act of Ontario shall be applicable to this By-Law.

290

A BYLAW to provide for levying and collecting County, School, Debenture, Library and Village General Purpose Rates for the Year 1921.

BE IT ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of SUTTON as follows:

That the following rates shall be levied and collected upon all the the rateable property within the said Village for the Year 1921

That the rates imposed by this ByLaw shall be paid to the Treasurer of this Corporation in Bankable funds on or before the 15th. day of December 1921 by the Collector in so far as the law will enable him so to do.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that an additional charge of five per cent shall be added to and collected on any taxes imposed by this ByLaw which shall not have been paid to the Collector of said Village before the 10th. day of December 1921.
