By-Law 301
A By-Law to govern Sale of Milk
and Inspection of Dairies

To take a vote of the ratepayers of the Village of Sutton entitled to vote on money by-laws on a question to be submitted whether the said ratepayers are in favor of a supply of electric power from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton deems it advisable to submit to the ratepayers of the said Village of Sutton, a question as to whether the said ratepayers are in favour of a supply of electric power from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Sutton enacts as follows:—

1. That the following question be submitted to the ratepayers of the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Sutton entitled to vote on money by-laws:

"Are you in favor of obtaining from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario a supply of Electric power?"

2. That the votes of the said ratepayers shall be taken on this question at the following time and places by the Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks hereinafter mentioned that is to say:

Saturday the 21st day of April, 1923, commencing at the hour of nine o'clock in the forenoon and continuing until Five o'clock in the afternoon at the undermentioned Polling places as set out below.

Those voters whose names begin with the letter A up to and including those whose names begin with the letter M at the Concert Hall in the upper story of the Town Hall, Sherman Brown, Deputy Returning Officer and Thos. Sheppard, Poll Clerk.

Those voters whose names begin with the letter N up to and including those names begin with the letter Z at the Council Chamber in the lower story of the Town Hall, R. C. Burnham, Deputy Returning Officer and Theo Railton, Poll Clerk.

3. A true copy of this By-law shall be published in the following newspaper on the days hereinafter mentioned, that is to say "The Express-Herald" Newmarket, on March 30th, April 6th, April 13th, 1923 and a copy of this By-law shall be posted at the Post Office, Jackson's Point, the Post Office, Sutton, A. Burrows' store and James Burchs' store, Sutton.

4. On the 18th day of April, 1923, at the Clerk's Office on High Street in the said Village of Sutton at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, the Reeve will in writing signed by him appoint two persons to attend at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk of this Municipality and one person to attend each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of the answering of the said question in the affirmative and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of the answering of the said question in the negative respectively.

5. The 23rd day of April, 1923, at the Council Chamber in the said Village of Sutton at 2 o'clock in the afternoon is hereby appointed for the summing up by the Clerk of this Corporation of the number of votes given in the affirmative and in the negative respectively made.

BY-LAW NO —

A By-law to provide for borrowing the sum of \$29,000.00 for the purpose of constructing an Electric Light System in the Village of Sutton and to authorize the issue of Debentures therefor.

WHEREAS it is intended of the said Corporation to construct an Electric Light System in the said Village of Sutton to properly carry and distribute Hydro Electric Power.

AND WHEREAS in order to enable the said Corporation to construct the said Electric Light System it will be necessary to raise the sum of \$29,000.00 by way of debentures.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to make the principal of the said debt repayable by annual instalments during the period of twenty years. Next after the issue of the debentures such instalments of principal to be of such amounts that the aggregate amount payable for principal and interest in any year shall be equal as nearly as may be to what is payable for principal and interest during each of the other years.

AND WHEREAS it will be requisite and necessary to raise annually in each year for the period of Twenty years during the currency of the debentures to be issued under this By-law the sum of \$2426.70 for paying the several instalments of principal and interest.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable property of the said Municipality of the Village of Sutton according to the last revised assessment roll for the year 1922 is the sum of \$469,878.00.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the existing debenture debt of the said Municipality is the sum of \$3012.25 and of which no part of either principal or interest is in arrears. Therefore The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Village of Sutton enacts as follows:

1. That for the purpose aforesaid it shall be lawful for this Corporation to borrow the said sum of (\$29000.00) Twenty-Nine Thousand and Doallrs and to issue debentures of the said Municipality to the amount of Twenty-Nine Thousand Dollars (29000.00) in sums of not less than One Hundred Dollars each payable in a manner for the amount and at the times hereinafter set forth.

2. The said debentures shall bear interest at the rate of Five and One-half per cent. per annum, payable yearly and as to both principal and interest shall be payable at the Bank of Nova Scotia, Sutton.

3. It shall be lawful for the Reeve of the said Municipality and he is hereby authorized to sign and issue the said debentures hereby authorized to be issued and to cause the same and the interest coupons attached to be signed by the Treasurer of the said Municipality and the Clerk of the said Municipality is hereby authorized and instructed to attach the corporate seal of the said Municipality to the said debentures.

4. The said debentures shall be payable in twenty annual instalments during the twenty years next after the date of the issue of the same and the respective amounts of the principal and interest payable during each of the said years shall be as follows:

5. That for the purpose of paying the said instalments of principal and interest as the same become due respectfully during twenty years the currency of the debentures to be issued under this By-law there shall be raised and levied in each year by special rate on all the rateable property in the said Municipality the sum of \$2426.70.

6. The debentures to be issued hereunder may contain a provision in the following words "This Debenture or any interest coupon thereon shall not after a certificate of ownership has been endorsed thereon by the Treasurer of this Municipal Corporation be transferable except by an entry by The Treasurer in the Debenture Book of the said Corporation."

7. This By-law shall come into force on a date of the final passing thereof.
