BY-LAW No. 338

TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF MONEY TO MEET CURRENT ORDINARY EXPENDITURE FOR THE YEAR.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the *billage* of *Sutton* to borrow the sum of *Eight thousand* dollars to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation and the sums required to be raised in the current year for High and Public School purposes until the taxes are collected.

AND WHEREAS the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section 319 of ~~Chapter 192 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario~~ the Consolidated Municipal Act, 1922, being 12-13 George V., Chapter 72 (Ontario) and Amending Acts.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-law by the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and the Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia on the note of the Corporation, or by way of overdraft, or otherwise, the sum of *Eight thousand* dollars (\$ *8,000* ) until such time as the taxes levied, or to be levied, shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.

2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and the Treasurer and the Bank.

3. That the Head and the Treasurer may draw, make and deliver promissory notes, bills or other securities and documents as may be agreed on, to secure the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-law.

4. That the Head and the Treasurer may enter into an agreement with the said Bank, sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and the Treasurer, providing for the borrowing of the said sum by the said Corporation, and the repayment of the same on or before the last business day of the current year, together with all other terms relating to such borrowing and repayment as the said Head and Treasurer may deem necessary.

## By-Law 339

To issue debentures to the amount of \$6500.00 for the purpose of purchasing fire fighting appliances and erecting fire fighting equipment, for the Corporation of the Village of Sutton.

Whereas Whereas the Municipal Council of the Village of Sutton deems it advisable to procure fire fighting appliances and erect equipment for same for the use of the said Village and to borrow for the said purpose upon the credit of the Municipality the sum of Sixty five hundred dollars (\$6500.00)

And Whereas to raise the said sum the council deems it advisable to extend payment for the same over a period of ten years as-foresaid by the issue of Debentures bearing interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum extending over a period of ten years as aforesaid.

And Whereas the amount of the whole rateable property (liable to taxation for such purpose) according to the last revised assessment roll being for the year 1927 is the sum of (\$582534.00) Five hundred and eighty two thousand five hundred and thirty four dollars, and whereas the debenture debt of the said Village of Sutton is Thirty three thousand five hundred and forty nine dollars and nineteen cents (\$33549.19) of which no part principal or interest is in arrears

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council Corporation of the Village of Sutton as follows follows;

- (1) That the Reeve is hereby authorized and required to issue debentures of the said Corporation to the amount of Sixty five hundred dollars (\$6500.00) which shall be marked and known as fire fighting appliances and shall be in the sum of \$6500.00 and shall be sealed with the corporate seal and shall be signed by the Reeve and Treasurer thereof, and shall be payable in ten years from the date hereinafter named by this By-Law to come into effect at the Bank of Nova Scotia in the said Village of Sutton with interest at the rate of 5% per annum as follows that is to say ten annual payments of eight hundred and forty one dollars and seventy cents <sup>seventy</sup> (\$841.77) each.

A By-Law to establish a Commission for the control and management and maintenance and construction for the supply of electrical power and energy for the Corporation of the Village of Sutton.

Whereas the Corporation of the Village of Sutton has entered into a contract with the Hydro Electric Power Commission ~~for~~<sup>of</sup> Ontario, under the Power Commission Act for a supply of electrical power.

and Whereas under chapter 249 section 33 of the Public Utilities Act, a commission may be established by By-Law by the Council of the Corporation for the Control and management of the construction operation and maintenance of all works undertaken by the Corporation for the distribution and supply of such electrical energy and power.

And Whereas the council of this Corporation deems it advisable to establish a Commission <sup>consisting of 3 members</sup> for the control and management of the construction operation and maintenance of all works undertaken by the Corporation for the distribution of such electrical power and energy.

Be it therefore enacted by the Corporation of the Village of Sutton that a Commission be established <sup>to be known as the Sutton Hydro Electric Power Commission</sup> under the provisions of the Public Utilities Act, to be elected by the people at the same time and place as the Council of the Corporation as set forth in the said Act, and to hold office as authorized by the Public Utilities Act.
