- 2 That the said Twenty Eight Lamps shall be furnished for not less than 17 nights in each month during the continuance of this Agreement.
- 3 That any lights ordered by the said Village in excess of Twenty Eight shall be chargeable pro rata as stated in Clause four of this Agreement.
- 4 That the said Village agrees to pay to A. J. Lowick & Son the sum of Two Hundred and Eighty Dollars for the lighting in each and every year as per Clause Four of this Agreement.
- 5 That said Twenty Eight Lights shall run from until 11.30 each night excepting on Saturdays when they shall run until midnight and on Sunday nights when they may be turned off at 11 P.M.
